Rules Governing Subscribers.

THE RULES OF THIS COMPANY WILL BE ENFORCED, THEREFORE READ THEM CAREFULLY.

1. Each subscriber shall have free use of any and all lines pertaining to this system, subject, however, to the following provisions governing the use of lines and telephones.

Business must always have preference over mere pleasure and amusement.

3. No one shall be entitled to the use of the lines for more than three consecutive minutes when someone else is waiting to use the line.

4. Do not ring on any line without first listening to see if the line is in use; if it is, wait a reasonable length of time and then ask for the use of the line.

5. Do not fail to ring off after talking through Central.

6. Do not drag your rings; give quick strong ones.

7. You know your own ring, answer it and leave other rings alone.

8. Be patient with Central, they are often busy.

9. Put your mouth about one-half inch from mouth-piece when talking.

10. A wait of ten seconds at a telephone seems like ten minutes: **BE PATIENT.**

11. Always hang receiver on hook with ear down, this keeps dust and dirt out of the receiver, and always replace the receiver on the hook as soon as you are through talking; this saves the batteries.

12. **DO NOT EXPERIMENT WITH THE TELEPHONE.**

13. Any person using the lines owned or controlled by this Company, who is not a subscriber, shall be charged a fee of fifteen cents, to be collected by the subscriber of the phone from which the message is sent as this fee will be charged to the account of such subscriber.

14. Death and funeral messages are free.

15. Any person or persons listening on the line when others are talking will, upon FIRST offence, have their phones taken out, and on no condition will they be allowed another phone.

16. No subscriber shall allow the free use of his telephone to any person not a subscriber, except it be a member of his family, his partner in business, his employe or guest whose home is not along the lines of this Company or who is a subscriber of another line which has free exchange with this Company.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this rule shall be charged with full amount of the message so permitted; in mind that Central can listen in at any time and will sooner or later detect violation of this rule.

17. A messenger fee of ten cents will be charged when the person called has to be sent out for by Central.

18. No profane, abusive or obscene language shall be permitted to pass over the line. Any person so offending shall be fined one dollar for each offence and shall be deprived

of further use of the line until said fine shall be paid.

19. Central will cut off all lines at ten o'clock p.m. and connect said lines to night gong which is to be rung only for emergency calls, such as for Doctors, fire, burglars or for the purpose of stopping a crime, which might be prevented by such call. All persons calling Central after ten o'clock p.m. except as above stated will be charged a fee of fifteen cents for each said night call.
