THAT the United States in Congress assembled, 1780, resolved that it be recommended to the said States, to make liberal cessions of their common benefit; and on the 10th of October 1780, the said States agreed that the territory ceded shall be formed into distinct republican states in union, having the same rights of sovereignty, freedom and independence, as the former States; and that each state which shall be so formed, shall have a right to the same territory, not less than one hundred, nor more than one hundred and fifty square miles, as near thereto as circumstances will admit. And that the said States, having made cessions accordingly, the latter found it necessary to enter into a compact, among others, as to the said condition; and that the said States, in order to bring the said condition into effect, entered into, on the 10th of October 1780, the said compact, and the said States, in consequence thereof, have since that time, been observing the same respecting it. And whereas, upon further consideration, it is found that a strict adherence to said condition in the division of the said territory, will produce many inconveniences to the settlers upon the said territory; to prevent which, and put it in the power of the said States to make such division thereof as shall be most beneficial to the said States, it is recommended to the said States, to make such division of the said territory as shall be most beneficial to the said States; and as the resolutions aforesaid of the 23d of October 1780, of the United States, in case the said recommendation shall be adopted, shall be such measures as might be for the general interest,

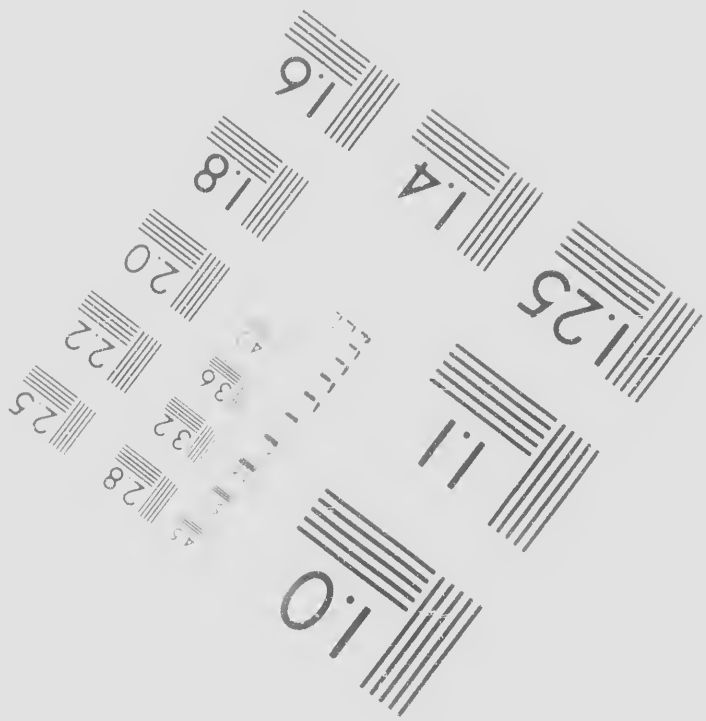
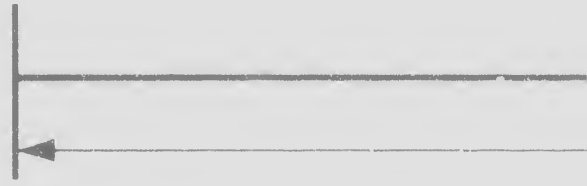
