| BRIIISH ARMY CASUAIIIES 381,983 <br> London, Sept. 14.-Official announcement was made today in the fist 21 was 381,983 officers and menkilled, wounded or missing. <br> Detalled figures of the casualties were announced as follows: <br> Killed and died of wounds-Officers, 4,965; other ranks, 70,992 . <br> Wounded-Officers, 9,973; other ranks, 241,086. <br> Missing-Officers, 1,501 ; other ranks, 53,466 . <br> These figures refer to the army alone. <br> The losses of the British army during the summer were somewhat smaller than In April and May. <br> The last previous statement of the total of British casualtiea was issued by Premier Asquith on June 9, it gave a total of 258,069 up to May 31. The losses from that time up to August 21 are theretwo months before the end of May, the period covered in the preceding announcement, the losses averaged about 2,000 a day. |  |
