

An Act to postpone for a limited time the issuing of Writs for the next election of Members of the Legislative Council.

An Act to postpone for a limited time the issuing of writs for the next election of members of the Legislative Council.

HEREAS, on the twentieth day of February, in the year of Preamble. Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and sixty five, the Legislative Council of this Province voted an humble Address to Her Majesty, praying that Her Majesty might be graciously pleased to cause 5 a measure to be submitted to the Imperial Parliament for the purpose of uniting the Colonies of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland and Prince Edward's Island in one government, with provisions based on certain resolutions which were adopted at a conference of delegates from the said colonies held at the city of Quebec on the 10 tenth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and set forth in the said Address; and on the fourteenth day of March, in the same year, the Legislative Assembly of this Province voted an humble Address to Her Majesty, containing the same prayer; and whereas the said Addresses were transmitted by His Excellency the 15 Governor, to Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies, to be laid at the foot of the Throne, and the said Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies, in a despatch to His Excellency, dated the eighth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, and communicated by His Excellency to both Houses of the Provincial 20 Legislature during the now last session, informed His Excellency that Her Majesty had been pleased to receive the said Addresses very graciously, and that Her Majesty's Government had seen with great satisfaction that both Houses of the Canadian Legislature had adopted Addresses to the Crown expressive of their desire for the accomplishment 25 of a measure calculated materially to add to the strength and promote the welfare of the Provinces of British North America; and whereas there is therefore recason to believe that the measure aforesaid for the union of the Provinces of British North America will be submitted to and enacted by the Imperial Parliament at an early date, and in view of the 30 said Union and of the changes which will be thereby effected, it is inexpedient that an election of Legislative Councillors for the Electoral Divisions of the Province hereinafter mentioned should be held during the present year; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as 35 follows:

1. For and notwithstanding any provision in the first chapter of the Periodical Consolidated Statutes of Canada, requiring the Governor to issue writs elections of on or before the first day of September of the present year, one thou-Legislative Councillors 40 sand eight hundred and sixty-six, for the election of twelve Legislative for certain Councillors to represent the Electoral Divisions of Culf Taralla Scand Councillors to represent the Electoral Divisions of Gulf, Lasalle, Saurel, Electoral Div-Repentigny, Montarville, Alma, Tecumseth, Gore, Erie, York, Catara-islons postque and St. Lawrence, and to make the same returnable on the first poned. Tuesday in November in the said year, such writs shall not be issued before the 16th day of Trib. before the 16th day of July, in the year, 1867, and the members 45 of the Legislative Council representing the said Electoral Divisions therein at the time of the passing of this Act, shall continue to be the

members representing the same in the Legislative Council until the day next preceding the return day of the writs (if any) to be issued on the day last aforesaid, for the election of their successors.

2. If it be not in the meantime otherwise provided by some Act of When Writs of election for the Imperial or Provincial Legislature, the writs of Election for the 5 such Electoral Divisions mentioned in the next preceding section, shall be issued on the day therein mentioned, and shall be returnable on issue and be the 17th day of September, in the same year; but the writs for the then next periodical election of Councillors for the said Electoral Divisions shall issue and be returnable at the periods when they would 10 have issued and been returnable without this Act.

Accidental vided for.

3. Any accidental vacancy of a seat in the Legislative Council for vacancies of any of the Electoral Divisions named in this Act, which may happen seats for said before the day to which the issue of the writs for the next periodical Divisions pro- vacancy is postponed by this Act, shall be held and deemed to be an 15 accidental vacancy happening within three months next before the regular periodical vacancy of such seat within the meaning of the twenty-second section of the said Act, the provisions of which shall apply to such accidental vacancies.
