



THE MARKET FOR BOTTLED DRINKING WATER IN MEXICO

Mexico is a federal representative democratic republic, with a land area of just under 2 million square kilometers, measuring approximately one-fifth the size of Canada. It is divided into 31 states and a Federal District in which the capital, Mexico City, is located.

According to preliminary figures from the latest population census taken in 1990, currently there are 81,140,922 inhabitants living in Mexico, 10.2% of which reside in the Federal District. If we take into consideration the municipalities located in the State of Mexico which are adjacent to Mexico City, the number practically doubles.

Prior to Mexico's accession to the General Agreement on Tariff and Trade during the administration of ex-President Miguel de la Madrid Hurtado (1982-1988), imports of bottled mineral (natural and/or carbonated) were marginal. The demand for bottled water, consisting mainly of carbonated spring water and potable water further treated by ultraviolet, reverse osmosis and other processes, was supplied by domestic bottlers.

It has often been stated that Mexico is sadly lacking in fresh water. This may certainly be true in some desert regions of the country, where rainfall is scarce and periodic long dry spells occur. However, there are numerous underground bodies of water in various regions, some of which are high in sulphur content and not fit for human consumption or are harnessed and used for recreational purposes or spas. In several Mexican states, underground springs have supplied fresh water and have been exploited for many years by domestic bottling companies.

Imports

Traditionally, the import market has been dominated by the USA. In 1985 the value of imported bottled water supplied by that country amounted to US\$784; in 1988 the USA accounted for 95.5% of the total import value, and 97.5% in 1989. Canada's share of the market was only 0.01% and 0.6%, respectively, in those years. During the past couple of years, however, brands from other nations including Germany, Italy, France and Spain have appeared in the market.

International Trade Policy

Mexico became a member of the GATT in September, 1986, subject to reciprocal tariff treatment with other member nations. As a founding member of the former Latin American Free Trade Area (LAFTA), revised in 1980 as Latin American Association of Integration (ALADI), Mexico exchanges certain preferences with other ALADI member countries. Mexico and Canada signed a reciprocal trade treaty in 1946, and Mexico enjoys "Most Favoured Nation Treatment" on Mexican commodities entering Canada. In July 1974 Canada further extended to Mexico special treatment under its "General Preferential Tariff" ruling, allowing for a wider spectrum of Mexican manufactured goods to enter Canada at reduced tariff rates. In 1988 both Mexico and Canada adopted the harmonized customs system (HS) currently in use. Since May, 1989, Mexican ad-valorem import duty rates range from a minimum of 5% to a maximum 20%, with certain commodities enjoying exemption from import duty payment.

Import Duties and VAT

Under the Harmonized System, bottled water is coded thus: 2201.10.01, mineral water; 2201.10.02, carbonated water; both are subject to 20% ad-valorem duty. Simple non-mineral, non-carbonated purified (potable) drinking water is classified as 2201.90.01 dutiable 10%. In addition to the above, imported drinking water pays about 6% of the invoice price as customs clearance charges, plus 15% value added tax.

Distribution Channels

Imported bottled water is distributed wholesale in the market by importers, distributors or representatives of foreign suppliers, who sell to retail outlets such as supermarket chain stores and department stores, and to leading restaurants, hotels, tourist resorts, etc. Bottled drinking water of domestic origin is distributed throughout the country via distributorships established by individual companies or "concessions" which handle a variety of brands by volume. Importers/distributors of bottled water, foreign producers and countries of origin are given in Annex I.

Import Requirements

Imported water does not require a license or permit. However, the importer, distributor, agent or representative must obtain a registration number from the Secretaría de Salud (Ministry of Health):

in order that imported products for human consumption may be marketed in Mexico. Products may be sold with the original labels affixed. However, the importer, distributor, agent or representative must place a sticker on each bottle or package identifying the producer and/or exporter, country of origin, name and address of the importer and the registration number provided by the Ministry of Health.

Doing Business in Mexico

For the Canadian company or business person who is inexperienced where dealing with Mexico is concerned, the following chapters will indicate some of the aspects that should be carefully considered, in order to achieve any degree of success.

Foreign Exchange

Mexico does not exercise any controls on the transfer of foreign exchange

tside the country. Importers are able to freely obtain irrevocable letters of credit, bank drafts, transfers or any other accepted means of payment to cover the costs of goods to be imported. The national banking system is in the process of re-privatization, in a effort to give it more dynamism and efficiency, enabling it to respond to the challenges which Mexico will be facing in a free trade environment in the future.

Documentation Requirements

Canadian exporters should request detailed instructions from their Mexican customers regarding the documentation requirements that must be met, in order to facilitate as much as possible the clearance through Mexican customs and entry of the goods into the country. Failure to adhere strictly to these requirements can signify fines to the importer, demurrage costs due to delays at the border, and in extreme cases the return of goods to the point of origin. Mexican importers must obtain sanitary and phytosanitary regulations from the respective ministries for food, animal and plant products prior to importing. Usually, copies of such documents accompanying shipping papers will help to facilitate inspection and entry.

Commercial invoices must be prepared in Spanish (original and seven copies) and visaed at the Mexican Embassy or Consulate in Canada. Bills of lading for ocean, rail, road and air shipment are also required. If the invoice is written out in another language, a translation signed by the exporter, consignee or custom broker attached to the invoice will suffice.

Experienced Mexican importers will usually provide the exporter with the name of a custom broker to whom the goods should be consigned, who will take responsibility for forwarding the goods on to destination.

Quotations and Payment

Unless otherwise indicated by the importer, price quotations should be given in U.S.A. dollars, f.o.b. plant plus transportation, documentation charges, etc; or f.o.b., c.i.f. or c.a.f. Mexican point of entry. The customer is then responsible for obtaining import documentation, payment of duties and transshipment from the border to destination.

Canadian exporters should ensure that their customers are fully informed about their methods and conditions of payment, usually by irrevocable letters of credit. However, some importers prefer to forward payment be bank transfers or drafts because of the reduced costs involved. In any case, Canadian exporters should protect themselves adequately, and ensure that monies are in their banks and available to them against the presentation of shipping documents. As mentioned earlier, foreign exchange is available through the Mexican banking system to cover the cost of imports.

MEXICAN IMPORTERS/DISTRIBUTORS OF BOTTLED DRINKING WATER

Transportation

Goods moving from Canada to Mexico travel mostly by truck or railcar. These services are provided by Canadian trucking firms or by U.S.A. rail systems which connect with Mexican road and rail systems at major border crossings. Mexican cabs and drivers must be used to haul loads over local highways to destinations inland.

Retail Market

With the relaxation and elimination of certain import barriers since its accession to GATT, Mexico has experienced an increased influx of goods from many nations. Bottled drinking water is no exception. Several brands formerly unknown in Mexico can today be found on supermarket shelves. For any product to gain a niche in this expanding market, it has to be well presented and price competitive. A recent survey taken in several commercial outlets show the differences in bottle sizes and prices currently in effect. At the time of writing the currency exchange equivalent was \$2,985.00 pesos per U.S.A. dollar. Please see Annex II.

Other Contacts

Apart from the companies presently representing the brands being sold in Mexico, there are other processed food importers, representatives or distributors who may be approached to determine if there is any interest in handling bottled drinking water, and their data is given in Annex III. Also included on this list are the names of major supermarket chain store operators.

The list of Mexican bottlers of mineral and purified drinking waters is long. Annex IV provides information on the principal companies, together with the brands under which they market.

Conclusion

This paper attempts to provide useful information to the Canadian company that is interested in exploring its opportunities in the Mexican marketplace. While every effort has been made to include the most up-to-date data, this work is not intended to be an in-depth market report, and the writer accepts no responsibility for omissions or inaccuracies. Introduction

Cards bearing from Census of Mexico given by Mexican or U.S. Government
service are being provided by Canadian Immigration Branch to the
Government of Mexico for use in their border crossings. Mexican consuls
and private mail may be used to mail these to the appropriate offices.

British Mexico

With the exception of certain institutions which have been established
since 1917, Mexico has no foreign embassies or legations. The
Government of Canada has no diplomatic representation in Mexico.
There are no diplomatic missions in Mexico City, nor is there any
such body as a Consulate General. For this reason no diplomatic
exchanges are to be had with the Canadian Government. It is recom-
mended that all business be conducted through the Canadian
Consul General in Mexico City, who is in charge of Canadian
affairs. Address see Annex II.

Other countries

Abroad there are Canadian embassies in Mexico,
Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Costa Rica, Ecuador, France,
Germany, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Peru, Portugal,
Russia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Uruguay,
