The Quarterly Meetings of this Committee shall be held in Toronto, on Thursday, 7th August, and Thursday, 6th November, 1873; and on Thursday, 12th February, and Thursday, 7th May, 1874. The members of the Committee are requested to give the Secretary early notice of their intention to be present at the Sessions, that provision may be made for their entertainment among the friends.

The attention of Missionaries is requested to the following Resolution of the Committee, passed in August, 1872:—That the Secretary shall, previously to each Quarterly Meeting, prepare a tabular view of the numerical and financial state of the missions; also a synoptical statement of the business to be done; and in order to do this, missions shall hold their quarterly meetings sufficiently early to enable them to have their reports to the Mission Office not less than one week previous to the meeting of the Committee; and in case any of the missionaries shall fail in doing so, their reports shall not be read, nor their grants sent, until the succeeding meeting. The Committee earnestly hope that all the brethren will assist in enabling the Secretary to carry out the above arrangement, so that they may have time to discuss what really pertains to the good of the mission work.

REPORT.

ADDRESS OF THE GENERAL MISSIONARY COMMITTEE.

*To the Friends, Collectors, and Ministers,
Of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada :*

DEAR FELLOW-LABORERS:—We have reached another point of review in our connexional labor. The mercies of another year call for thanksgiving; its failures for humiliation; its successes for renewed consecration and deepened confidence. The events which have marked the social and political and religious life of Canada during the past twelve months show, with increased clearness, the profound human needs which only the Gospel can meet; the holy results of Christian work, where Christ is received into the spiritual life of men; and the utter failure of every other remedy for the evils which oppress and destroy the people. Never before did your Committee realise so fully the grandeur of our work. To spread a knowledge of Christ and His salvation; to make known the provision He has made for human redemption; and the principles He has given for the guidance of human life, is to engage in a service which seeks the highest interests of the nations, and the ultimate enthronement of the Son of God in the conscience and heart of the world. To this magnificent enterprise we have, with scrupulous economy, devoted the means which your offerings to God have placed in our hands. To prosecute this mission still further, we appeal to your consciousness of its importance and of your obligation and discipleship to Christ. We shall not ask in vain.

During the past year the hand of God has been with us on our Mission Stations in Canada. Twenty of these stations report increases. On several others there are decreases reported; but on the whole the Committee are grateful for the sleepless mercies which have crowned their labors.

The amount of money placed at our service during the past

year was \$8,090 63 raised on our Canadian work, \$1,939 25 granted to us by the English Conference, making a total of \$10,026 88. It is gratifying to find that the Missionary money is somewhat in advance of last year, which, even so late as Conference, was not anticipated. Yet it needs to be much more enlarged, seeing that the disbursements have over-run the receipts to by no less than \$885 31. We again urgently appeal to friends of the cause of Christ to make the income exceed the disbursements. Let our stations in this country decide on making the income \$10,000 00. It can be done. And being done would relieve the Committee of embarrassment. By the means at our disposal we have been unable to assist forty-three stations which are still dependent on the Mission Fund for help. The amounts granted to these stations are very much less than their necessities required. In consequence, many of our faithful brethren are suffering very considerable discomfort and distress. We are sorry we have not the means to aid them more liberally, we would gladly lighten their burdens, and enter into several pressing calls for new Missions to be established, but we cannot do this until, visited by a blessed baptism of the Holy Spirit, our people shall rise up in their strength and dedicate themselves and their substance more fully to the service of God. The question of extending and sustaining our work is in the hands of our collectors and contributors.

There being pressing requests from Orillia to commence a Mission in that town, the prospects being so good, the November meeting decided to send Bro. Parrish to begin the work. He succeeded very well for three or four months; an exchange was then effected between him and Bro. Dyke, who has done well. They have a membership of seventeen, and the quarterly income is \$34 91. Preparations are being made for the erection of a good Church in this rising town, and the Committee have the fullest confidence that, under the superintendence of the Rev. H. Harris, Orillia will become a prosperous station.

Muskoka has been richly prospered during the year, and, at the earnest request of the authorities, the Conference has stationed a third preacher to that station, with the understanding that his labors will be chiefly devoted to the district of Three Mile Lake.

We are still unable, for lack of funds, to open a Mission in Montreal, although we earnestly desire to do so; nor can we, for

the same reason, accept the urgent call which has come to us from Manitoba. We commend these facts to the prayerful consideration of our friends. Shall we still lack the means? The men are ready. They wait to go—we wait to send them; it is for you to say how long the delay shall be. Let there be an increase in our missionary income this year, which shall average only one dollar each for our whole membership, and we could immediately open four new Missions, probably more. Is this too much to ask? Friends of the Redeemer, try.

THE HOME BODY

Shows us a splendid example of advancement and liberality. Never before did the connexion, of which we form a part, cover so wide an area, employ so many agents, rear so many temples, or tell so mightily upon the world's spiritual life. The work, begun by a few humble men but a few years ago, is now amongst the mightiest of the powers of Christendom.

HOME.

Our missions in the United Kingdom are advancing. Thirty-eight new places have been successfully missioned during the past year. Twenty-seven new schools have been established. Twenty additional chapels have been built or bought. Eight new school-rooms have been secured. More than 3,600 open-air services have been conducted, and nearly 200,000 pastoral visits have been made to the homes of the people. These general statements represent both great labor and blessed success. The following selections may serve as samples.

FOREIGN.

In South Africa the Rev. Henry Buckenham is still without a colleague; but Miss Martin, who has become his wife, has been sent out to him during the year. His report of the financial help rendered by the people is very pleasing; but the spiritual results are not yet satisfactory. His faith is being severely tested. But harvest will follow seed-time. The rains will yet descend, and the seed sown will bear fruit.

In Western Africa our brethren are still cheered with evidences of spiritual success. In Southern Africa both costs and results are light. In Western Africa costs are heavy, but success is great.

Mr. and Mrs. Maylott have been obliged to return to England after enduring much suffering and doing good service in the African climate; but the Rev. W. B. Luddington and his excellent wife have gone to fill the vacated places at George's Bay. The Rev. W. Holland is still laboring successfully at Santa Isabel. Besides these European missionaries we have three native assistants employed at Fernando Po. But we need another station at Biappa. If we had one English missionary at Santa Isabel, one at George's Bay, and another at Biappa, from these central places, and with the aid of native assistants, we could evangelise the whole population. We have men ready for the work, and waiting to go; but we lack the means to sustain them. Brethren, help Africa! Sunday scholars, help Africa!

COLONIAL.

New Zealand has been constituted a district. Three new stations have been formed, and four additional missionaries are now employed, and an increase of eighty-four members is reported for the year. Two more missionaries are urgently wanted. The Rev. W. Tinsley has been engaged, and will proceed to Auckland this summer, and the Rev. C. Waters will remove to Thames.

The Sydney District includes all the stations in New South Wales and Queensland. Two additional stations have been formed during the year, and a net increase of sixty-two members is reported.

Melbourne District includes all the stations in Victoria and Tasmania. Eleven of these are self-sustaining; but we have eight missions in Victoria, and four in Tasmania. The secretary for that district says, "There has been a very good work in several of the missions, and some very striking conversions; but in consequence of adverse circumstances in some stations, the net increase for the missions is only three."

Adelaide District in South Australia includes seventeen stations, half of which are still dependent on the Mission Fund.

SUMMARY.

We have in the United Kingdom 64 missions, 11 circuit missions, and 126 missionaries; in Canada, 38 missions and 46 missionaries; in New Zealand, 6 stations and 7 missionaries; in New South Wales and Queensland, 20 missions and 22 missionaries;

in Victoria and Tasmania, 12 missions and 12 missionaries; in South Australia, 6 missions and 7 missionaries; in Africa, 4 stations and 6 missionaries; total, 150 missions and 226 missionaries.

The amount contributed at the Metropolitan Anniversary in 1872, was £212 os. 1d.; received by the treasurer apart from district returns, £703 12s. 2d.; received from chapels, being repayments, interest, &c., £480 12s. 6d.; collected in Australia, as far as reported, £458 9s. 8d.; collected in Canada and expended on missions there, £1,661 12s. 6d.; Santa Isabel missionary meeting, £40 os. 6d.; contributed in home districts, £21,538 13s. 1d.; making together £25,095 os. 9d.; but to this sum should be added £3,517 12s. 6d., contributed on the home missions for the support of the missionaries; and £3,644 18s. 0d. for the building of chapels and schools, making the total amount contributed for the support and enlargement of our missionary operations, £32,257 11s. 3d., being the largest amount ever realised by the Society in one year, and being only 19s. 5d. less than was reported for the fifteen months included in the last year's report.

We now enter upon a new year. We do so amidst circumstances which demand deep prayerfulness, and inspire new confidence. The sympathy and co-operation of our brethren in England was never more cheerfully or fully rendered. This year they have increased our grant nearly five hundred dollars, and whilst we must all desire, as speedily as possible, to become a self-sustaining body in this great Dominion, it is a source of profound satisfaction to us to know that whilst we need help, that help will be rendered, with a cheerfulness and liberality which show how real and strong and undying is the union of heart and hand between us and the Parent Body.

Another circumstance which will strengthen our hands is the settlement of an agitation which did very much to unsettle our societies, and to shake confidence in our permanence. No doubt need longer exist. We shall remain a distinct and permanent organisation in Canada. Nothing can avail to shake us in this determination. God has raised us up in this land, His hand has been with us, and we will never abandon the work He has given into our hand. It is but forty-four years ago that a single, zealous Primitive Methodist raised his voice on the streets of Little York, and preached Christ to the people, who listened in the open-air.

Then we had not a class, not a church, not a Sabbath-school in the whole country. The man who thus raised our banner for Christ is still living—he addressed our last Conference. And to what has this work grown? We have nearly a hundred ordained ministers; we have over sixty stations, some of them wealthy and powerful circuits; we have one hundred and thirty-six Sabbath-schools, in which nearly twelve hundred teachers are laboring to lead more than eight thousand children to the feet of Jesus. We have Church property worth nearly two hundred and nineteen thousand dollars; whilst we have in church-fellowship with us six thousand six hundred immortal souls. In the very city where the lone preacher first lifted his voice, we have now four independent circuits, with a membership of six hundred and seventy-two. Surely the blessing of God is upon us in this country. Let us return from the entertainment of any other question to ask, how can we best build up our branch of Christ's Living Church? For this let us labor and pray and give and, if need be, suffer.

We commend the claims of this Society to its friends. We ask for an increased income, and we pray most fervently that God may richly pour out upon all our people the healthful spirit of His Grace. Amen.

BOOK ROOM REPORT.

Last year's report recommended larger premises being occupied. This matter was left by last Conference in the hands of your Committee. Just on the close of Conference, Mr. C. A. Backas, of 107 Yonge Street, made us an offer of his establishment, and after considerable negotiation, an agreement was entered into, by us accepting of his lease, extending to 1st July, 1874, and purchasing of his stock to the amount of \$3455 84; and also the fixtures and furniture, for which we pay \$822. This was a weighty responsibility to assume, and yet it was thought that if possible we should extend our Book business. In that we have succeeded, the business done during the past year being much larger than ever before. Still, the success of the undertaking is yet a trial, as our expenses are unavoidably much larger now than in the past. Were it not that there are so many pressing claims just now, an effort to pay the debt on the stock by subscription would be a proper step. And thus, free from the payment of interest, the Book Room would be in a position to aid the other funds of the Church. One thing our people can do, and in speaking to their representatives in Conference assembled, we are indirectly speaking to themselves. Our people can purchase their books, stationery, etc., of their own Book Room. By so doing they could put beyond question the success of the establishment. Many of our people purchase their Sabbath School Books at the Book Room, and for this we thank them; but why not their Day School Books as well? All we want is a little thought, and a good share of patriotism. Patriotism is a grand thing, and with a reasonable amount of it we shall succeed beyond any doubt.
