## ANNUAL PREPARATORY MEETING.

---

Thursday, the 9th day of November, A.D. 1882, having been declared a day of Public Thanksgiving, the meeting of the Society called for that day was adjourned until the 10th November, and was duly held at the Queen's Hotel. There was a large attendance of members. The chair was occupied by James Michie, Esq., President. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted, and many new members were elected and proposed. The Managers—Messrs, Malcolm Gibbs, R. Swan and Stephen Nairn—submitted their report, of which the following is a synopsis :

### Report of the Managers of St. Andrew's Society for 1882.

Your Managers, in submitting to you this evening their annual report, have much pleasure in stating that, in consequence of the abundance of work, the number of persons who have been in the habit of demanding relief has been considerably reduced.

While the demands upon our charity have not been so frequent as in the past, we have in all real cases of distress been enabled to give more abundantly, and we have found in our experience that prompt and liberal relief is the only efficacious way of benefiting the applicants. A liberal advance gives them encouragement and the means of making the upward start, whereas small sums given at intervals do less good, relieving, it may be, for a time their present necessities, but making them come back as periodical beggars, and helping to crush the natural spirit of independence

which all the genuine Scotch possess. Most of the applicants for relief this year have been women, and they tell sad tales of suffering.

We find many cases of genuine distress, and the pleasure we have in affording them assistance compensates for the many deceptions attempted to be practised upon us.

The bestowal of charity has its bright side, and, amidst all discouragements, we have our Master's promise.

We have issued 106 orders upon our Treasurer, for the sum of \$262.75; \$112 of this was given to pensioners upon your bounty; the balance, \$150.75, was given to fifty persons in sums varying from 50 cents to \$25.75. The large sum of \$25.75 was given, under promise of repayment, to a young Scotchman whom we found suffering from illness and starvation.

We have assisted several parties to return to Scotland by advancing part of their passage money. Many newly-arrived emigrants have been assisted by your Managers in obtaining situations; and in connection with this, we have to express our thanks to the President and other officers for their readiness at all times to render us whatever assistance or information we required.

In a discussion which ensued as to the best mode of distributing the funds of the Society, a high tribute of praise was given by the President to the Managers. He clearly explained the arduous and often thankless nature of their duties, and showed how well their task was performed. On motion their report was adopted, and on further motion a vote of thanks to the Managers for their valuable services was unanimously carried.
