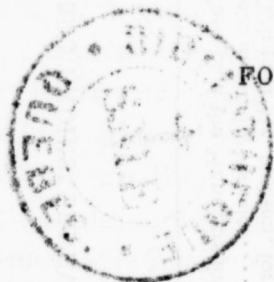

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE
FOR THE YEAR 1841-2.

THE past year having been marked by a considerable increase of the tide of emigration to the inviting shores of our Western world, it was a consequence of this, which was to have been anticipated, that there has been an augmented demand on the compassionate solicitude and the benevolent generosity of the friends of "*the poor and the needy*." And to this has been added the requirements for relief occasioned by the frequent afflictions which have occurred during the year among the resident inhabitants of humble condition in life. To both these descriptions of necessitous individuals the Committee of THE QUEBEC LADIES' BENEVOLENT SOCIETY has been a most welcome almoner of the valuable bounty of its respected Contributors.

In making this Report the Committee do not fear they shall exhaust the commiseration of their Constituents, by presenting their Benevolent Institution as a Cause which still solicits their continued and if possible increased assistance. The Committee have too real a confidence in the charitable sentiments already evinced by their Subscribers, to admit such a conclusion. And on this account they trust that through the blessing of God, they shall never, by any falling off in their pecuniary resources, be reduced to the painful necessity of withholding the soothing consolations of substantial sympathy from the unpitied anguish of "*him who is afflicted*."

The Supporters of the Quebec Ladies' Benevolent Society will be happy to learn that its business has been regularly conducted on the same acceptable principles, which in former years have governed its proceedings, and secured their approbation.—

Uniformly have the deserving poor been assisted without any sectarian or national distinction: and the Books of the Society record all the requisite particulars of each case for the satisfaction of its Friends. The working Committee of Ladies have continued their highly-appreciated contribution of unpaid labour, in making "*coats and garments for the poor.*" And several gentlemen, during the year, have kindly sent in acceptable presents of useful articles, which have been most gratefully received, both by the Committee and by the joyful and necessitous recipients of their thoughtful "*liberality.*"

The number of articles provided since the date of the last Report, is 1002; of which 911 have been distributed to 420 individuals, as follows:—
