## KITCHENER WANTS MORE MEN

The 55th N. B. and P. E. I. Regiment must be recruited to full strength within ten days. Every fighting unit we can send to the front means one step nearer peace. Who Will Enlist Today for Overseas Service?

The ${ }^{\text {bu }} 5$ th $N, B$, and P. E. I, Regiment requires from six hundred to seven hundred men. We must have seventy mien a day to make up the required number within the time limit.
