

An Act to Incorporate the St. Joseph's Union of the Village of Industry, in the County of Joliétte.

WHEREAS the persons hereinafter mentioned, inhabitants of the Preamle. Village of Industry and of the neighbouring parishes, and associated together under the name of L'Union St. Joseph de L'Industrie of the County of Joliette, have by petition, prayed to be incorporated : 5 and whereas the said Association has been formed for the purpose of enabling its members mutually to assist one another by means of monthly contributions to be paid by each member into the hands of the Treasurer or other officer of the said Association : and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petitioners : Therefore, Her 10 Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. Pierre Imbleau, Alexis Demarais, Joseph Myet, Clément Demarais. Joseph Fréchette, Thomas Sheppard, M. J. Viau and Joseph Ouimette, together with such other persons as now are members of the said institution, or may hereafter become members thereof, in virtue of this Act,
