SCHOOLBOY'S WONDFBFULL TRIR. Mears undortook the feat with the
support of an important Ameriean

thirty minutes. Mr. Mears left New York for Paris on July 2nd. From

days in 1889 . The earliest Inown
trip round the world was that of the
Magellan expeilition in $1519-1522$. These hardy adventurers took three
years over their voyage.

record was set up, a modern travel-
ler might lower jt. A journey round
the world to-day would take considerably longer than thirty-five days.

have to use the route which the early record-breakers followed-that is, by

means of one of the fastest liners;
