

BILL

"An Act to enable the Corporation of the Mayor and " Councillors of the City of Quebec, to borrow an " additional sum for the construction of the Water "Works."

HEREAS the Corporation of the Mayor and Councillors of the City of Quebec have by their Petition Preamble. represented that it is necessary to enable them properly to carry into effect the Act passed by the Legislative Council 5 and Legislative Assembly in the ninth, and assented to by Her Majesty in the tenth year of Her Reign, and intituled, " An Act for supplying the City of Quebec and parts adjacent "thereto with water," and the Act amending the same, passed in the session held in the thirtcenth and fourteenth years of 10 Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "An Act to amend an "Act for supplying the City of Quebec and parts adjacent "thereto with water," and have prayed for authority to enable them to borrow an additional sum of Fifty thousand pounds current money of this Province, and for authority to increase 15 the rate or assessment to be levied under and by virtue of said acts to the uniform rate of one shilling and six pence currency, upon the annual assessed value of all property within the said City; and whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer.

Be it therefore enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Power to bor-20 Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative row £50,000 Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of more, making in all £175,000 Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the for the Quebec Water Works. authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, "An 25 " Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower-Ca-"nada, and for the Government of Canada," and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for the said Corporation to borrow an additional sum of money not exceeding Fifty 30 thousand pounds, making altogether a sum of One hundred and seventy five thousand pounds current money of this Province, for the purpose of establishing the said Water Works. and to issue Debentures or Corporation Bonds, to that amount, under the hand of the Mayor and the seal of the said Corpo-35 ration, payable on the first day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy, unless the said Corporation shall see fit to redeem the same at an earlier period, with the consent of the holders thereof; upon which Debentures or Corporation Bonds interest shall be payable semi- annually on the first day of November and May in every

year, which interest may amount to and shall not exceed the

rate of seven per centum per annum. Provided always, that all and every the provisions in the said Act contained, relating to the issuing of the Debentures or Corporation Bonds therein mentioned, and the monies to be obtained by means thereof, shall apply equally to the provisions of this Act and the Debentures or Corporation Bonds herein mentioned and the monies to be obtained by means thereof, except so for as altered by this Act.

Water-rate not to exceed is. 6d. in the £ on the assessed annual value of occupied houses and 9d in the £ on that of stores &c.

II. And it shall and may be lawful for the said Corporation, when and so soon as they are prepared to supplied the said 10 City or any pasts thereof with water, to specify and declare by a by-law, that the proprietors or occupiers of houses, stores, and similar buildings in the said City, or in such parts thereof as they are ready to supply as aforesaid, shall be subject to the annual rate or assessment, payable at the periods to be 15 fixed by the said by-law, to the said Corporation, which rate or assessment shall not, however, be made payable before the water is ready to be supplied to the proprietors or occupiers by the said Corporation, and shall not exceed one shilling and six pence in the pound on the assessed annual value of the houses occupied and one half that amount on stores and similar buildings; Provided also, that no other or further charge than the said rate or assessment of one shilling and six pence in the pound shall be made for the supply of the water as aforesaid, any thing in the said Act or in this Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

1st and 3rd sections of 13 & 14 Vict. c.100; repealed in part.

III. And be it enacted, that the first and third clauses respectively of the Act last cited in the preamble to this Act, shall be and the same are hereby repealed in so far as the same relate to the rate or assessment to be levied by a by-law of the Corporation, and in so far also as the same relate to the sum of money to be borrowed for the purpose of establishing the said Water Works.

IV. And be it enacted, that this Act shall be a public Act.
