BILL.
An Act to divide the County of Haldimand.

WHEREAS by the existing division of the County of Haldimand, the Townships of Seneca, Oneida, Rainham and Walpole are attached to the said County for the purposes of Representation in the Legislative Assembly and Registration of Titles only, and are for all other purposes attached, the two former to the County of Wentworth, and the two latter to the County of Norfolk, by which unreasonable division great and manifest public inconvenience is occasioned; And whereas it is expedient to remedy the said grievance: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this Act the said Townships of Seneca and Oneida shall be detached from the said County of Haldimand for the purposes of Representation in the Legislative Assembly and Registration of Titles, and shall be attached for these as well as for judicial, municipal and all other purposes, to the said County of Wentworth; and the said Townships of Rainham and Walpole shall in like manner be detached from the said County of Haldimand for the purposes of Representation in the Legislative Assembly and Registration of Titles, and shall be attached for these as well as for judicial, municipal and all other purposes, to the said County of Norfolk.

Certain Townships detached from the County of Haldimand, and attached for all purposes whatever to the Counties to which they are now attached for certain purposes only.
