WHEREAS it is expedient to revive and further to continue the Acts Preamble, hereinafter mentioned, which, in consequence of the unexpected termination of the now last Session of the Provincial Parliament, were not continued in the usual manner: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and 5 with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:-

1. The Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the Session Acts of Canaheld in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and in-da 10, 11 Via tituled: "An Act to enlarge the powers of the Trinity House of Mon- cap 1. 10 treal, in certain cases where the Public Health of the City may be endangered;" the Act of the Parliament of this Province passed in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled: " An Act to incorporate the Grand Division and Subordinate Divisions of the 14, 15 Vic. Order of the Sons of Temperance in Canada West;" the Act of the cap 159. 15 Parliament of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed in the second Acts of L. C., year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, and 2 G. 4, cap 8. intituled: "An Act for better regulating the Common of the Seigneurie of Laprairie de la Madeleine:" the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the same year of the same Reign, and intituled; "An Act to enable 20 the inhabitants of the Seigneurie of La Baie Saint Antoine, commonly ² G. ⁴ can 10. called La Baie du Febvre, to provide for the better regulation of the La Baie St. Common in the said Seigneurie," as amended and extended by the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the fourth year of the same Reign, and intituled: "An Act to authorize the Chairman and Trustees of 25 the Common of the Scigniory of the Baie Saint Antoine, commonly 4 G. 4 cap. 26. called the Baie du Febvre, to terminate certain disputes relating to the limits of the said Common, and for other purposes appertaining to the same;" the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the ninth year of the same Reign, and intituled: "An Act to alter and amend an Act, passed 30 in the sixth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled: 'An Act to 2 G. 4 cap 32. authorize the inhabitants of the Fief Grosbois, in the County of Saint Fief Grosbois.

• Vic cap., 30 make provision for the same object throughout the Province of Canada," and the Act amending the same, passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: "An Act to continue and amend the 13 Vic., cap. Bankrupt Laws, now in force in this Province," in so far as the same 18. are continued by and for the purposes mentioned in the Act passed in 5

the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: "An Act to make provision for the continuance and completion of proceedings in 13 & 14 Vic., Bankruptcy now pending," and the said last mentioned Act; and the

Act of the said Parliament, passed in the Session held in the thirteenth Continued for and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: "An Act 10 to afford relief to Bankrupts in certain cases," shall respectively be and they are hereby revived and continued, and shall be in force for the purposes aforesaid from the passing of this Act until the said first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and thence until the end of the next ensuing Session of the Provincial Parliament, 15 and no longer; and shall be held to have been in force from the end of the now last Session as if then continued for the said purposes, except only in cases where the expiration thereof may have been pleaded before the passing of this Act.

Proviso. Act not to prevent the effect of any Act of this Session.

3. Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the 20 effect of any Act passed during the present Session, repealing, amending, rendering permanent, or continuing to any further period than that herein appointed, any of the Acts hereinbefore mentioned and continued, nor shall continue any provision or part of any of the Acts in this Act mentioned, which may have been repealed by any Act passed 25 during the present Session or in any previous Session.

4. The period limited by the Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: "An Act to amend the Acts passed to remedy certain defects in the Registration of Titles in the County of Hastings," as that within which it 30 shall be lawful for the Registrar of the County of Hastings, to receive and index any memorial, under the authority of the Act of the said 9 Vic. cap. 12. Parliament, passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: "An Act to remedy certain defects in the Registration of Titles in the County of Hastings, in Upper Canada," or of the Act of 35 10 & 11 Vic., the said Parliament passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: "An Act to alter and amend an Act intituled, 'An Act to remedy certain defects in the Registration of Titles in the County of Hastings, in Upper Canada," or to endorse any Deed, Conveyance, Will or Probate, to which such 40 end of Session memorial relates, shall be and is hereby extended to the said first day after 1st Jan., of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and thence until the end of the then next ensusing Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer, and shall be held to have been so extended from the end of the now last Session until the passing of this Act, except 45
