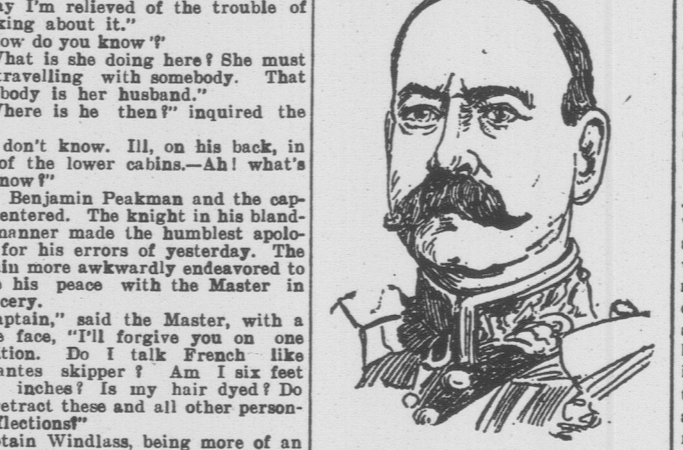

BIG FISH - A few days ago Mr. Alex. Fraser, of Kingsport, Kent Co., killed a 17 months old pig which weighed 473 pounds, and Mr. Peter Edward, of the same place, slaughtered one which tipped the scales at 476 lbs.

CONVICTED AND ESCAPED - The trial of George Guthrie, of Acadiaville, for operating an illicit whiskey still, was concluded last Friday. Guthrie was fined one hundred dollars and thirty days imprisonment. He escaped from Constable D's residence during the night.

THREE MOOSE KILLED - Last Friday night the express train from Moncton struck three moose which stood on the track near the Bersey plain and killed all three. They were 1-2 on the line, but one was carried all the way to New-Westport on the pilot. All the meat was properly dressed and when the engine returned next day one of the heads proved to be a trophy of the occasion.

MR. LANG'S FORTUNE - By the death of Alphonse Sandison, of Eureka, Wisconsin, Mr. Thoreau Lang, formerly a school teacher at Bathurst, N. B., has become a millionaire. Mr. Sandison, who was a resident of St. Anthony, N. B., became one of the heirs to a large estate. Mr. Lang is married to a daughter of the late James Melanson, Bathurst Village. Mr. Sandison is said to have been a wealthy merchant for a long time, whose wife was an accomplished pianist.

FRONTIER RAILROADS - From the beautiful residence in Fredericton of Hon. Archibald Fitzgerald, was the news of a joyous occasion on Wednesday afternoon of last week, when his youngest daughter, Miss Myra, was married to Captain Eaton of the Royal Canadian Artillery, E. Quebec. The ceremony was performed by Very Rev. Don Edgington. About fifty guests were present, including the Minister of Railways, Hon. A. G. Blair.

UNPARALLELED TOURIST SLEEPING cars for the accommodation of passengers holding second class tickets, are run by the Canadian Pacific Railway on Trans-continental Express train, leaving Windsor Station, Montreal, at 2 p.m. every Thursday and running through to Seattle, and at 7 p.m. every Friday from Chatham Junction to Vancouver. Passengers to Calgary and west thereof accommodated in these cars on payment of small additional charge for berth; each berth will accommodate two passengers.

SEVERE TROUBLE - Marshall Reid, of Dalhousie, who, under the name of T. Reid & Son, runs a shoe and planing mill at Campbellton, is in financial difficulties. It is said that his liabilities are about \$5,000, of which amount about \$2,000 is secured by mortgage. Local men are the largest secured creditors, but it is said that some St. John business houses are also creditors for quite an amount. Assets are probably worth \$10,000, but at a forced sale will not realize that amount.

I. C. R. RECORD RUN - The English mails on the S. S. Labrador, which left Halifax on the Inter-Atlantic Railway special train at 4 o'clock Sunday afternoon, was delivered to the postal authorities at Bonaventure station at 2:30 o'clock Monday afternoon, the Inter-Atlantic R.R. having made the run from Halifax to Montreal, 837 miles, in the fast time of twenty-three hours and a half. It said last week: "AN EYE-WITNESS - An Alderman of St. John, was an spectator at the Council chamber on Monday evening, 'What do you think of our Town Council?' asked an alderman. 'I think you have a splendid Council chamber,' replied the Island Revenue official."

TWO BIG STEAMERS. BREMEN, Dec. 9. - The Canadian Steamship Company has bought from the North German Lloyd Steamship Company the express steamers Fulda and Werra. The vessels are to be delivered in January, after the expiration of their lease to the Compania Transatlantica for the transportation of Spanish soldiers from Cuba to Spain. They will run between Milford Haven and Papeete in connection with the Atlantic and Lake Superior Railway Company.

CAMPBELLTON, Dec. 10. - It is reported here that the Atlantic and Lake Superior Railway's preparations at Papeete are not sufficiently advanced to permit the steamer from Milford Haven to land other passengers or freight there next week. It is also said that Capt. Yates, the manager of the steamship line, has been inquiring as to the possibility of landing passengers and freight at Dalhousie and obtaining cargo there.

QUEBEC, Dec. 9. - The wharf at Papeete being not yet completed, the steamer Gaspe, of the new Canadian Steamship Co., will go to New Carlisle to discharge cargo on arrival in the Basin des Chateaux from Milford Haven. Marine Pigeon, steward, and a party of men leave to-night to be in readiness for her on her arrival.

A Great Contest. NEW YORK, Dec. 10. - Charles W. Miller is the champion long distance bicycle rider of the world. At ten to-night and thirty seconds after ten o'clock tomorrow the pistol was fired, the most remarkable contest in the history of cycling came to a close. Miller and his trainer, who has put him through so many contests, merited round the track while the hand played "There'll be a hot time in the old town to-night."

Walter Wolford Miller, and received no favor an ovation. Then came Pierce, then Albert, Ginn, Lawson, Aroun, Nawn, Foster, Stevens, Hill and Julius. It was a noisy crowd and it vented its feelings in shouts that turned the garden into a bedlam of noise.

Miller received \$1,700, Waller \$1,000, Pierce \$800, Albert \$400, Ginn \$300, Lawson \$200, Aroun \$150 and Nawn \$125, and the rest \$100 for finishing. The winner takes extra for bringing his earnings for the week up to \$5,000.

The management makes something out of the race, how much they could not say to-night. Last night there were not so many as had been expected, owing to the doubling of the price of admission. As the men paraded the track for ten minutes to-night, some smoking, all smiling, there was nothing average to six-day racing to be seen in their appearance.

Two of the riders broke the best record of the world, 1,983 miles 850 yards, made by Miller, the correct record of last year's race. Waller, the second man, was two miles ahead, and Miller, the winner, nearly twenty-four miles. Miller had his previous mark at 6:35 o'clock, Waller at 9:02. The contest lacked all the features which previously made six-day racing objectionable.

An event of last evening on the track was the marriage of Miller to his bride, Miss Hanson and Alderman Wentz stepped to the front of the box. "Ladies and gentlemen," said he, "I have been asked to unite Charles W. Miller and Miss Genevieve Hanson, both of Chicago, in marriage. I wish your close attention while the ceremony is being performed, and have been requested by the management to be as expeditious as possible, as Mr. Miller

is anxious to return to the track to finish his grand ride."
