A friend has sent notes of Highland emigration to Pictou. The ship Nora arrived from Fort with five-hundred emigrants. There was sixteen weeks on the passage. fever broke out and sixty-five died of it. She was kept in quarantine for six weeks, after which her passengers were landed in a storm.
