| In South Africa. <br> Pretoria, Transvaal, July 15.-The settlement of the annexed territor; is not being accomplished without considerable friction. This is especially noticeable in the bitter hatred and persecution on the part of the Boers who stayed in the field to the end of the war to Boers who served as. British scouts. It is expected some of these native scouts have been shot or beaten. <br> So intense is the feeling that many of the burghers who fought to the end distinguished themselves from those who surrendered during the war by wearing a green badge. The Transvaal and Free State colors are also freely worn and this custom is encouraged ny the Dutch who did not take an active part in the war, Many of the burghers declare they were induced to agree to surrender by the false representations of their leaders, who painted the terms too rosily. <br> Discordant elements are numerous and any attempt to place the burghers who surrendered during the war In authority over those who fought throughout, will conceivably result in a renewal of hostilities. The majority of the Boers have apparently in to way abandoned their nationality, and some of them preach the advisability of opening Dutch schools so as to keep alive thefr nationality.
