LORD RANDOLPH REPELS HIS TRADUCTION.
He Declares That the Charge That he Ever Favoured Home Rule is a Lie, and Says That he Has Sincere to Give Optimal Results.

LONDON, March 2.—Lord Randolph Churchill has written a letter to the Daily News describing the statements in a leading article of the London Standard and Lord Ashurst, a prominent member of the House of Commons, had prepared a scheme of home rule for Ireland as the latest of all falsehoods ever emanating from a newspaper.

He says, "I have never departed from the opinions expressed in my speech at Edinburgh on Dec. 20, 1883. It is absolutely false to say that Lord Randolph's government ever wavered in its resolute hostility to a repeal of the union or anything approaching it."

In the speech referred to Lord Randolph said that the Tories would not yield an inch on the home rule question and would make any further concession to Mr. Parson's scheme of home rule a disgrace to the local government question. He added the address of public money on the subject was a disgrace to the local government question.

JOHN MORLEY'S PROGNOSTICATION.
