The Cattle Dehorning Commission resumed work yesterday under the chairmanship of Hon. Charles Dwyer. Commissioners present were: Mr. H. Glendonning of Manilla, Dr. Andrew Lancaster, Mr. Richard Gibson of Delaware, and Secretary J. J. Kello. The time was principally occupied in examining witnesses concerning the merits and demerits of dehorning.
