#### CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

lumber prices appear to have settled down to a winter basis, and the fluctuations for the next two months are likely to be very slight. Navigation is about closed, mills are shut down, and manufacturers are now in a position to estimate the quantity of unsold stock. That it will be found exceptionally small is admitted on all sides. The upper grades of pine are about out of the market, and before spring they will be very eagerly sought for. A large manufacturer informs the writer that there would be no difficulty in advancing the price of No. 1 and 2 cuts and dressing, but that it is not considered advisable to do so, as it would probably encourage the use of substitutes for white pine and when the supply had become greater there might be found to be less demand. There is a good er quiry for box lumber, considerable shipments being made to the Eastern States. Hardwoods remain high and firm. A shortage in supply prevails generally, but especially in basswood, elm and ash. Dealers are refusing orders for basswood on account of the searcity of stock. In Toronto shingles are remarkably firm, although the conamption: not large. British Columbia shingles are likely to be advanced. The active demand for togs is a splendid indication of the strength of the lumber market. Manufacturers evidently fear a mild winter with its consequent effect upon higging operations and are endeavoring to protect themselves against such a contingency by arranging as far as possible for a supply of ogs in advance.

#### QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Spruce lumber is unusually scarce, but as the demand has slackened the prices generally remain unchanged. There has been a further slight appreciation in the price of clapboards, which are new selling on the basis of \$42 to \$42.50 for extras, Boston delivery. Shingles are steady although some of the smaller manufacturers are shading prices slightly.

The shipments from the St. Lawrence are practically completed for the season. It is believed that they have been lighter then last year, owing to the fact that the high insurance rates have caused shippers to export to a greater extent via the United States ports. Wintering stocks at Ouebec are small.

#### MANITORA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA.

In this issue will be found the price list adopted by Bruish Columbia manufacturers on lumber for delivery at Manitoba points. Following this list comes the

announcement, unofficially, that it is the intention of the British Columbia Lumber and Shingle Manufacturers' Association to advance the price of shingles ten cents per thousand, to take effect on April 18t next. This advance has become necessary on account of the increased price of logs and higher wages and insurance rates. The lumber demand throughout Manitoba and the Territories has slackened somewhat, but present indications point to a fair trade throughout the winter and an early and active spring demand. The recent fire at Norman by which 14,000,000 feet of white pine were destroyed has stiffened the price of that class of lumber

#### UNITED STATE.

Receipts of white pine at distributing points have been quite large of late, and wholesale dealers will go into the winter with a larger supply than was anticipated one month ago. They continue to make heavy shipments to interior points, indicating that retailers do not regard their supply as more than ample to meet the requirements of their customers. Prices of pine have, if anything, strengthened during the week. No. 2 and No. 3 grades of shop common have been somewhat weak for some time past, but as it e result of an investigation made by Minneapolis dealers the supply was found to be much smaller than estimated and accordingly prices have stiffened. In the Chicago market No. 4 and No. 5 boards are in excellent demand and within a month prices of No. 4 boards have advanced fully \$1 per thousand. Factory lumber, especially in selects and better, is very firm. Numerous orders, for door and mill work are reported from Chicago, where the wholesale trade is more than seasonably active. From Cleveland, Ohio, it is learned that hemlock and Norway piece stuff continues strong, this being particularly true of Norway in 2 x 12 of all lengths. The price of 18 foot lengths and under is \$23, with steady buying at this price. Box manufacturers are making liberal purchases of No. 4 lumber.

The shortage in lumber stocks is forcibly illustrated by the supply at Alpena. The docks there will go into winter quarters with less than 2,000,000, feet as against 20,000,000 feet at the close of navigation last year.

#### GREAT BRITAIN.

Although the British lumber market is quiet, the undersone is strong. A statement has been issued by the Swedish Saw-Mill Owners' Association, giving the basis of an agreemen, which has been reached for curtailing the log production this

winter. It appears that seventy-nine leading shippers in Norrland and Dalarne, representing an export of over one billion feel, have agreed to reduce the quantity of logs taken out by about 21 per cent. This has established a conviction that there will be no excessive supply next season and for this reason importers are more inclined to contract. Very little business has been done as yet in Canadian lumber, but prices are stiffening in all directions. It is reported that a London buyer recently offered £66 per standard for some first quality dry pine boards, landed on dock. Spruce prices are firmer, Recent sales reported include a quantity of second quality spruce deals, 3x9, at £9 158 per standard c.i.f. London, and some third quality at Lo. For landed stocks agents are asking £10 10s for 3x9 seconds, £9 158 for thirds, and £8 158 for fourths.

#### STOCKS AND PRICES.

Manufacturers in the Minneapolis district are paying \$6 to \$7 a thousand for cutting timber and driving it to the boom company's reach.

The Bell Telephone Company are calling for tenders for poles, to be delivered next spring, for the building of a line from Sault Ste Marie to Thessalon.

Mershon, Schuette, Parker & Company will carry over in Ontario this winter over forty million feet of lumber and logs. They have not bought heavily for next season's stock.

A two square mile timber limit at Young's Cove, Grand Lake, N. B., was sold by the New Brunswick Government last week to the St. John Sulphite Pulp Company at \$55 a mile.

Capt. Carter, of Marcan, and Albert Pugsley, of Athol, N.S., have purchased a block of timber land in Nova Scotia belonging to the estate of the late James Skidmore, of Canaan. The consideration was \$4,600.

G. Strevel, of Winnipeg, Man., has secured the contract from the Canadian Northern Railway to take out 250,000 ties during the present winter. His camps will be located at Banning, about fifty miles from Fort Francis.

Shingle prices in the Saginaw Valley are said to be a little easier. Dealers are quoting \$4.10 for XXXX white pine shingles and \$3.10 for clear butts. Cedar shingles are worth \$3.90 for 4 x 18 inch stocks and \$2.90 for clear butts.

The Department of Interior at Ottawa is asking for tenders up to December 24th for a license to cut timber on Berth No. 318, situate in the Province of British Columbia, to the east of Harrison Lake. The berth contains an area of 1080 acres.

The saw mill at Trout Lake, B.C., has passed into the hands of a syndicate represented by W. Cowan and D. L. Kinman, who are calling for tenders for the cutting of 1,500,000 feet of logs to be delivered at Trout Lake before the opening of spring. The timber limit secured by the syndicate contains 600,000,000 feet of fir, spruce, cedar and hemlock timber.

The demand for slack cooperage stock has subsided, as a result of which there has been a slight decline in prices. At Buffalo jobbers quote 6-foot pacent hoops at \$11 to \$11.25 and 534 foot at \$10.50 to \$10.75. Heading is without change, 31/2 to 5% cents for first class and 3% to 3% cents for second-class. Staves are firm and somewhat higher, the quotation being

\$7.75 to \$8 for first class elm and \$4.50 to \$4.75 for second-class. An effort is being made to advance the price of flour barrels.

#### TIMBER LIMIT TRANSFERS.

A.E. Alexander, of Campbellton, N. B., is announced to have disposed of his timber limits and mill property on the north shore ton syndicate, of which D. Richards, of Campbellton, is a member. This price is said to be \$110,000.

A deal is reported to have been closed by which the timber limits and mill property of E.D. Davison & Sons, of Bridgewater, N.S. have passed into the hands of a New York syndicate. The limits comprise 210,000 acres and are claimed to be the most valuable timber property in Nova Scotia. The consideration is believed to be about one and one-quarter million

The market for headock is easy at the recent decline, with a fair demand: Boards, 12, 14 and 16 feet stock, \$14.50 to \$15 50 for good eastern; Pennsylvania, No. 1, \$18 to \$19; No. 2, \$15 to \$16.

The situation holds very firm in western pine, the demand being good for the season: Uppers, 1 to 2 in. \$82 to \$85; 234 to 3 in. \$87 to 4.8; 4·in. \$90; selects, 1 in. \$65; 121 to 134 m. \$70;
