Convocation in Grant Hall—Installation of Chancellor and Principal. After devotional exercises conducted by the Principal Emeritus, the Very Reverend Daniel Miner Gordon, C.M.G., D.D., LL.D., the Principal will be installed by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, and robed by Mr. J. M. Farrell, Registrar of the University Council, and Mr. Francis King, K.C., ex-Registrar. The Chancellor will then be installed by the Vice-Chancellor and robed by Mr. J. M. Farrell, Registrar, and Mr. D. M. McIntyre, K.C., ex-Registrar of the Council. The Chancellor and the Principal will give addresses.
