# Great Western Railway Library.

---

## B Y · L A W S .

---

1. That all Books, Maps, Documents and other property or matter now, or hereafter attached to, or forming part of the Library, shall be vested in, belong to, and remain the property of the Great Western Railway Company.
2. This Library shall be for the benefit of, and confined to employés, and wives of employés, of the Great Western Railway.
3. The subscription shall be one dollar per annum, payable annually or half-yearly in advance.
4. No book shall be loaned and no member allowed any of the privileges of the Library, until such subscriptions are, from time to time, first duly paid.
5. The Committee of Management shall be composed of a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, and thirteen members—seven to retire one half year, and six the next, and four to form a quorum; and if any member shall absent himself from three successive meetings, the other Committee members shall elect some one to take his place.
6. The General Superintendent of the Great Western Railway shall be the President, and the heads of departments Vice-Presidents, and members of the Committee, ex-officio. The Committee, and Secretary and Treasurer, shall be chosen by ballot of the members at the half-yearly general meetings, when a majority of the votes cast shall be requisite to constitute an election. Six of the Committee shall be elected in January and seven in July, to replace members retiring.
7. Previous to the election of officers, the general meeting shall appoint two members not being candidates to act as scrutineers.
8. A registry of members entitled to vote shall be placed in some conspicuous part of the Library by the Secretary, at least thirty days previous to each half-yearly meeting.

9. The President only shall have a casting vote.
10. The President shall call a special meeting of the Committee upon the application of two-thirds of the members of the same.
11. The Committee shall call a special general meeting upon application of twenty members.
12. Two Auditors shall be appointed at each half-yearly general meeting to examine and verify the Treasurer's accounts, previous to their being submitted to the next general meeting.
13. All accounts shall be certified by the Managing Committee.
14. The Librarian shall see that all books and periodicals are kept in good order and condition, and shall make and keep catalogues of the books of this Library, and shall perform (under the direction of the Committee of Management) any other duties appertaining to his office.
15. The half-yearly meetings of the members of the Institute shall be held on the last Friday in January and the last Friday in July.
16. Due notification of half-yearly or special meetings shall be given by notices posted in the Library.
17. If, at any future time, there should not be twenty members belonging to the Institution, it shall be closed until the society is re-established.
18. None of these Rules shall be altered or rescinded, or other rules added except at a general meeting, and not then unless notice has been given to the Secretary, who shall cause such notice to be exhibited in the Library at least seven days previous to the meeting at which the alteration is to be proposed.
