THE PACIFIC CABLE SCHEMES A GLED

Postmaster-General Makes a Long Explanation Showing the Steps Taken to Expedite the Enterprise.

Lord Strathcona Instructed to Get the Work Under Control at Once—Mr. Richardson Puts Up a Fight For Railway Reform.

QUAWA, March 7.—(Special.)—An ardent advocate of the Pacific cable scheme is Mr. Casey, who has shown his interest in it on many occasions of late. This afternoon he asked the Government to take a full and complete view of the present situation of the scheme, and hoped that the Postmaster-General would not feel his tongue tied by the so-called confidential communications that have been made to the Government.

As to the composition of the Cable Board Canada's representatives were Lord Strathcona and Lord Aberdeen, and the other members were the same as last year. He pointed out that apparently a change had taken place in the application of the Eastern Extension Co. for cable privileges from Australia.

On Jan. 15, 1900, Sir Wilfrid Laurier called the Premier of Victoria, explaining that Canada considered the proposed granting of the concessions as an attempt to obstruct the Pacific cable, and sure to endanger its construction.

Mr. Mulock's Opinion Asked. When the report of the Eastern Extension Co. was submitted to the House of Commons, Sir Wilfrid Laurier asked Mr. Mulock to give an opinion on its bearing upon the Pacific cable.

Again the Colonies Were Cabled. Mr. Mulock then continued the reading of a letter from Sir Wilfrid Laurier, dated Jan. 22, 1900, in which he had asked New South Wales, New Zealand, Queensland and Victoria, expressing the hope that no hitch would occur regarding the Pacific cable.

Then Comes the Break. So far nothing new, but now comes a break. On February 22, 1900, Mr. Mulock advised Sir Wilfrid Laurier that the Cape cable was laid, not to give concessions to the Eastern Extension Co. until the Pacific cable was laid.

Mr. Mulock emphasized the fact here, viz., that this was the first time that the Australian Government had interfered with the granting of concessions to the Eastern Extension Company.


This Was New to Canada. Canada had never conceived this departure. This matter would destroy the foundation upon which the estimated cost of the cable was based.
