BIBLE CHRISTIAN MISSIONARY SOCIETY.

The Society occupies seventeen stations in Canada West; six in Prince Edward Island; and six in the United States of America: on which there are laboring 38 Missionaries, assisted by 122 Local Preachers. Upon these Missions there are 86 Chapels and 103 other preaching stations; 3,153 persons in church fellowship; 3,015 Sabbath School children, taught by 487 teachers.

The affairs of the Society are managed by a Committee appointed annually by the Conference.

# REPORT.

—:O:—

The friends of the Bible Christian Missionary Society watch with deep interest from year to year the success which attends the labors of its increasing Agency. Themselves, many of them, the immediate fruit of its labors: still largely partaking of its benefits, and contributing yearly to its funds, such an interest in its operations may reasonably be expected. To all our supporters we are thankful to report a good degree of success, in winning precious souls to Christ, in consolidating the interests of the Church, as well as in extending her borders. The increasing liberality of our friends has greatly cheered our hearts, and strengthened our hope of future prosperity. We have abundant evidence of the perfect adaptation of the Gospel of Christ to every class of character with which it comes in contact; accounts reach us from every Mission of conversions to God; in some of large ingatherings, embracing old and hardened sinners, and many of the young and rising race, some of whom are already giving promise of future usefulness in the Lord's vineyard. The Church must depend mainly on her own sons and daughters—those brought to God through her own instrumentality, as her future missionaries, not only for home operations, but also to mission heathen lands, and thus to do her part in bringing in the latter day glory, when the kingdoms of this world shall have "become the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Christ." With this object in view means should be adopted to assist young converts of sterling piety, and good natural abilities, to procure such an education as they require to qualify them for future usefulness as heralds of the Cross.

We have much cause of gratitude to Almighty God that but one of our missionaries, Bro. H. Stevens, has been removed by death: early in the present ecclesiastical year, he was called from the ranks of the Church Militant to join the triumphant hosts before the throne. Zealous, energetic, and successful, still comparatively young in years and with the promise of future usefulness, Infinite wisdom saw fit to summon him from the Church he loved, leaving an affectionate wife and five young children to mourn their loss.

Another of our Ministers, Bro. G. Bodle, has been called to mourn the loss of a dearly beloved wife. In both these cases the bereaved have been Divinely supported: each of the departed having left a bright testimony behind that they are gone to "be with Christ, which is far better." We have accounts from almost every Station of several members having passed away triumphantly to the skies.

From some of the pastors we hear the "voice of mourning, because the ways of Zion languish," deploring the lack of success in bringing souls to Christ, and weeping over backslidden sons and daughters. Others are jubilant from the fact that during the year they have seen the work of the Lord prosper in their

hands, and are consequently greatly encouraged, to devote themselves afresh, and with redoubled energy, to the work of the Ministry.

In the Cobourg District we are happy to notice that the downward tendency which has been evinced for some years, in a decrease of members, is arrested; and that after making up for a number of removals, several deaths, and backslidings, there is a small increase, and in the Quarterly and Missionary receipts a large advance on the past year. From the reports of some of the pastors we discover an increasing desire to concentrate labor in the centres of population; in our towns and villages. This we consider a step in the right direction. Peterboro report says: "The town requires regular Ministerial labor, both in the pulpit and also in pastoral visitation, in order to secure and maintain the position we desire in this growing and prosperous commercial centre. The report from Dummer says:

"The usual attendants of home mission toil have been experienced. Clouds and sunshine; bitters and sweets; the cries of penitents, and the scoffs of mockers; the songs of new born souls, and the sad notes of backsliders, have mingled during the year.

Seymour seems to present a brighter aspect than for several past years. The pastor says: "This year we have aimed more at consolidation, than extension. We have made some little progress. Sinners have been converted to God; the congregations in most places have increased; about seventy have signed the temperance pledge. We have a small increase in our membership.

In Huntingdon the societies are reported as living in peace; congregations good, and the week night services, with few exceptions, well attended. A Sabbath School was opened last year and another this, with the most cheering prospects. The Quarterly and Missionary receipts are far in advance of last year. At Zion a new shed, stable, and carriage house have been built and paid for.

The Hungerford pastor says: "This mission has suffered much, through the heavy affliction of its minister. Nevertheless our prospects are brightening. Thirty have united with the Church during the year; and our receipts are considerably in advance of last year, enabling us to meet all expenses.

From Perrytown we hear earnest breathing for a deepening of the work of grace in the hearts of professors, and an awakening from that state denounced in God's Word—"Woe to them that are at ease in Zion." The members are nineteen more than last year. Financially we have exceeded our most sanguine expectations; our missionary receipts alone being over \$70 in advance of those of last year."

From Oshawa, Bro. Ebbott, who during the greater part of the year has been seriously ill, and for some time thought to be on the brink of the grave, reports: "This station has passed through a severe crisis in the affliction of its pastor and members. Yet, amidst our discouragements, we are progressing, our congregations are good, and with care and the Divine blessing we hope soon to become a self-supporting circuit."

The Prince Albert report says: "Our prospects are encouraging; one new place has been opened for preaching, and two new Sabbath Schools organized, which are likely to prove very successful. The Mission is too large for one preacher; here is plenty of ground and work for two, if they could be sustained. Our missionary receipts are in advance of last year.

The pastor of Pickering mission reports: "Considerable effort in the chapel department; Bethel chapel has been painted, and the debt on it and the burying ground all paid off. The debt on Ebenezer chapel is reduced from \$120 to \$40. The preacher's house is tolerably well supplied with furniture; he also speaks of very refreshing seasons in the house of God, and an increase in the congregations."

From Scott mission we learn that the special services held during the winter were attended with some success, but owing to the number of removals and other causes, the number of members is less than last year. Missionary receipts are also behind; but upwards of \$120 have been raised for chapel purposes.

From Fenelon mission we have tidings of success. God has graciously poured out His Holy Spirit in different parts of the station, and about sixty souls have been added to our Zion. Three places have been re-opened and societies formed. Zion chapel has been painted and a shed erected, and at Fenelon Falls a site for a chapel and parsonage purchased.

The pastor of Mitchell says: "If prosperous Sabbath Schools, increasing congregations, societies living in peace, the awakening of sinners, numerous conversions, believers pressing after higher attainments of grace, and the liberality of members in support of the Gospel, are proofs of prosperity, we are not without these proofs. About 100 have been admitted into society, and we have a net increase of 73 meeting in Church fellowship. A Circuit house has been built—cost of lot and house \$1,500, present debt \$335."

From London comes the cheering intelligence: "A reviving shower has been poured upon us. Many have given proof of a Divine change, some of the older children in the Sabbath School have given evidence of a change of heart, and eight or ten received notes of admittance into society. The debt on the church is entirely discharged. An eligible site has been purchased, adjacent to the chapel, for a minister's house, on which \$100 has been paid, and the trustees have about \$200 in hand as a nucleus of a building fund. We think it would be well if London could be worked alone as a station, and Lambeth and Delaware, with other ground, be worked as a separate mission."

The Dereham report states "That at Putnamville a commodious chapel, 30 by 40 feet, has been built at a cost of \$700, of which over \$500 has been paid. At Zion, long a barren and unpromising field, the work has graciously revived, and 20 have been added to the Church. Bethel has also experienced seasons of refreshing; ten have been added to the society. A society of six members has been organized at Moone's Mills. Missionary receipts a little in advance of last year."

The pastor of Osborne mission mourns that greater success has not attended the efforts put forth, though some have cried for and obtained mercy through faith in Christ. The brick chapel mentioned in last year's report was opened for Divine worship on the 21st of January. It cost \$550, which sum we expect will be met by collection, and proceeds of tea, and subscriptions due in the fall of the year. A new brick parsonage has been purchased for \$625, \$260 of which is paid. At Bethany, they intend to build a new sanctuary, and \$700 have been promised towards it. Our missionary receipts are considerably in advance of last year.

At Clinton Mission the number of members is somewhat less than last year; at Oasis, thirteen have been admitted on trial, and in the neighborhood of Zion,

in the regular prayer meetings, some have been led to Christ; a new class has also been formed, and two Bible classes have been organized which give promise of much good. The Sabbath School in Clinton has steadily increased in interest; some of the scholars have been converted, and a good library obtained for the school. Both the Quarterly and Missionary receipts are in advance of last year.

The pastor of Grey has to lament the havoc made among the professed followers of Christ by strong drink. Serious disadvantage has been encountered at the town plot on account of the unfinished state of the church. The number of members is 37 less than last year, consequent on the withdrawal of the second preacher. The church at Anleyville has been comfortably seated, and land promised at Oxtaby's to build a church when funds are provided. The societies are living in peace.

From the Wisconsin District we have nothing remarkable. The pastor of Palmyra Mission, after describing the state of things, says:

"Our Ensign is "Holiness to the Lord,"  
Our Watchword "Forward,"  
Our Prayer, "Thy Kingdom come."

The Lisbon report informs us of strenuous efforts to pay off old debts, and make the preacher comfortable, in which they have succeeded. The Sabbath Schools are in a good state, and the finance in advance of last year.

The pastor of Little Prairie, after reviewing the past year, comes to the conclusion: "We have arrived at a crisis in our identity as a station, which resolves itself either into an amalgamation with the Palmyra Station, or drawing heavily from the missionary funds."

Illinois "Has suffered in consequence of not having a regular Preacher among them, during the year. Many members having been scattered, and wandered back into the world. A few, notwithstanding, have lately been inquiring after salvation, and if the Station were regularly supplied with preaching, there is a prospect that good would be effected.

From Yorkville the accounts are not very different from the usual tone of Mission reports, mourning over backsliders, lack of promptness on the part of officers, &c. Still some things, and some places, seem encouraging; there is a small increase of members, and no financial embarrassment.

The reports from Prince Edward Island District all agree in the fact of having had a very severe winter, greatly retarding the work of God; as in many places the Sabbath and week day appointments, could not be attended: the same of course must be the case with class meetings, prayer meetings, and Sabbath Schools. There is a decrease of members. Financially, they have done moderately. The Pastors on every station speak hopefully of brighter and better days.

On some stations they have been making strenuous efforts in Chapel building, and from the little Island comes the cheering note,—the first Jubilee chapel erected to commemorate the important era in our Church history.

The pastor of Vernon River circuit says: "Jubilee Chapel, 25 by 35 feet, has been erected at Cherry Valley, and the necessary sum raised, within \$80, to make it a free gift to the Lord." We have an account of ten deaths from the Island, all of which, according to the testimony of the preachers, were triumphantly happy. How cheering the fact that every year so many precious souls are entering the happy spirit land, the result of our missionary operations.
