Because the sentiments of large classes in this country was enlisted on the side of the south, because the claims of the United States have been preferred in too peremptory a tone, or because they have not been preferred, on those grounds, against France also, it does not follow that we should turn a deaf ear to complaints—of our conduct in recognizing the Confederate States. 

The silver question is still troublous.

We observe that a movement is being made in Montreal to gather up and export two or three hundred thousand dollars. This would slightly mitigate, though it would by no means remove, the nuisance. We have several millions of dollars in American coin passing from hand to hand in Upper and Lower Canada, with Montreal could and would again be itooded. It is plain, therefore that any action of the sort indicated above could only afford a temporary alleviation. The fifteen per cent, now levied upon American silver will effectually prevent futher importations; but how shall we get rid of that already in the sountry? The only practicable plan, in opinion, is for the banks to buy up and export the whole of it, for the sake of getting their own notes and Canadian silver into more extensive circulation.

Why cannot this be done.—Advertiser.
