A. R. Milne, C. M. G., Collector of Customs, was advised yesterday by telegram that Professor Asser, the Dutch jurist who was appointed arbitrator to settle the amount of damages due to the four United States sealing schooners seized by Russia at the same time as the Cape Horn Pigeon, owned in San Francisco, and the Kate and Anne of Seattle, owned by the James Hamilton Lewis, of Seattle, seized by the Agent of Copper Islands, was awarded \$32,444.
