BEAUTIFUL PORT COLBORNE

WHERE PROFITS ARE REAPED FROM NATURAL GAS

A Village of Bright Prospects—An Ideal Location for Manufacturers—A Pleasure Resort Patronized by Canadians and Americans—Some of Its Special Features—A Centre of Trade.

There is no prettier spot in Canada than Port Colborne. Situated at the southern end of the Welland Canal and bordering on the waters of Lake Erie it combines beauty of location with magnificent facilities for manufacturing purposes. In the first place the village is the terminus of the Welland division of the G.T.R., and the main line of the Buffalo and Godolphin division passes through it. In the second place all the boats plying between Lake Erie and Lake Ontario must pass up and down the canal between the two main thoroughfares.

A year ago they commenced operations, and to-day they are sinking new wells all the time. Their seven wells alone yield nearly 1,000,000 feet per day. One well yields 500,000 feet to the square inch. To fully comprehend what this means without seeing the well is impossible. A local newspaper requires a steam pressure of some 800 pounds to draw a train of cars, but to manage a pressure nearly seven times as great requires all the ingenuity of man. The Company intend to lay a main line to Port Colborne in the near future. The gas is used in all the villages along the canal.

Port Colborne's Pleasure Resorts. No more delightful spot in which to spend the summer can be imagined than Port Colborne. The broad beach of Lake Erie forms an excellent bathing place. 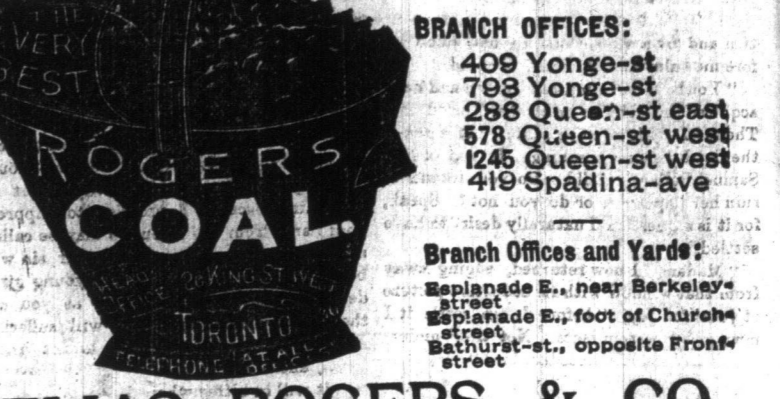
