Steadily the British troops are pressing forward toward the Peronne-Bapaume road, the main artery immediately be-
find the German lines north of Combles. After taking 500 yards of trenches southwest of Le Sara, General Sir Douglas Haig's men made additional progress in the capture of 500

The British occupation of territory between Thiepval and the Ancre is being contested strongly by the Germans. A German counter-attack, following the entry of the British
