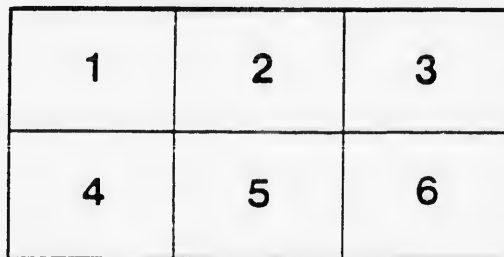
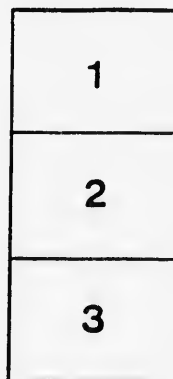

RULES, TITLES AND OBJECTS.

This is to be called the GRAND TRUNK RAILWAY LITERARY AND SCIENTIFIC INSTITUTE.

The object of this Institute is to supply its members with means of instruction, in Science, Literature and the Arts, by the establishment of a Reading Room and Library, for the use of its members, the delivery of Lectures, the institution of Classes, and the providing of Specimens and Drawings.

All discussions on Controversial Divinity, Party Politics, and Local Controversy, are strictly excluded.

Admission and Contribution of Members.

Any employee may become a member by the recommendation of two members, and the approval of the Committee, by the payment of ten cents per month, in advance, the recommendation to be delivered to the Secretary, shall produce it at the next meeting of the Committee, or Sub-Committee, who shall meet once a fortnight.

An annual subscription of one dollar paid in advance will entitle the member to the full benefits for one year.

Members' Cards are not transferable; and any member lending his card for the purpose of introducing a person not a member of the Institute to any of the meetings or privileges, shall upon proof, be fined 25 cents, and be excluded from all privileges till the fine be paid.

No member under the age of eighteen years can vote at any election or meeting, or nominate a member for office.

Any member being three months in arrears will be notified by the Librarian, that if such arrears are not cleared off within one month after such notice he shall cease to be a member of this Institution, and shall not be again admitted to membership till such arrears are paid.

Honorary Members.

The following persons may be elected Honorary Members of the Institute, upon the recommendation of the Committee: Annual Subscribers of Five Dollars, donors of Twenty-five Dollars, persons who have rendered valuable services to the Institution, and persons eminent in Science, Literature, or Art.

Constitution.

The affairs of the Institute shall be managed by a Committee composed of a President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer, to be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting in June.

Thirteen Members are to be elected to form the Managing Committee, six or seven of whom shall retire half-yearly by rotation, the three senior members of retiring committee shall not be eligible for re-election till six months after date of retirement; should there be no difference in the term of office of said members, lots shall be drawn at least fourteen clear days prior to General Meeting. This Committee to consist of members having the largest number of votes. Vacancies occurring in the Committee during the half-year to be filled by those members for whom the largest number of votes were recorded at the previous election.

That any member of the Managing Committee absenting himself for three successive meetings, unless he gives satisfactory reasons for so doing, shall be considered as having vacated his seat, and be dealt with accordingly.

The names of retiring members of the Committee willing to serve again, to be exhibited in the Reading Room seven days preceding the half-yearly General Meeting, such publication being considered as a nomination for their re-election. The names of all new candidates, with their proposers and seconders, must also be posted in the Reading Room seven days preceding the half-yearly General Meeting

That any member of the committee of management being directly or indirectly connected with any society, club, institute or association by which connection the said member may derive any financial or other benefit from proceeds or profits of any entertain-

ment given by the society, club, institute or association (in the building managed by the G. T. R. L. & S. L.) to which the member of the committee may be connected, shall have neither voice or vote while such questions are under discussion.

All elections to be by ballot; members to produce their tickets at election, if required; no member under the age of 21 years eligible to serve as a committee-man. Eligible members must have been six consecutive months connected with the Institute.

Two Auditors, not members of the Committee, to be appointed at each half-year general meeting, to examine the accounts previously to their being submitted to the General Meeting. The Auditors to have the right of a continuous audit.

The Committee will cause the accounts of the Institute to be made up by the Secretary each half-year, and lay them, with all books of accounts, bills and receipts, or other documents or vouchers relating thereto, before the auditors, and give them such information as they may require to enable them thoroughly to investigate the accounts.

The half-yearly general meeting will be held in the month of January, the day to be appointed by the Committee, seven days' notice being given.

At all General Meetings the chair to be taken by the President or one of the Vice-Presidents, or, in their absence, a Chairman shall be elected by the meeting.

At all meetings of Committee, five members will form a quorum; they shall have the power of making By-laws, but which must not infringe on the present Rules.

They shall divide themselves into as many Sub-Committees as may be necessary to facilitate the business of the Institute; these Sub-Committees shall report to, and be guided and directed in all their proceedings by, a majority of the General Committee. All acts of the Committee shall be submitted to the revisal and approval of a General Meeting.

Any member, who considers he has cause of complaint against the By-Laws or other transactions of the Committee, may appeal to a General Meeting.

Any member of this Institute may propose at the half-yearly General Meeting any resolution, provided he has given notice of his intention to the Secretary, who shall exhibit such notice in the Reading Room seven days before the General Meeting at which it is intended to be proposed.

The Committee to have power to make such charges for Classes and Lectures as circumstances from time to time may require ; they shall have the power of purchasing, exchanging, and accepting gifts or loans of books, and establishing Regulations for the use of the Library, Reading Room, Lectures, and Classes ; such regulations to be considered as Rules of the Institute.

No resolution involving any alteration in the Rules can be proposed at a General Meeting unless notice to that effect has been posted in the Reading Room one fortnight previous to such meeting, and the precise words of such Resolution specified in the notice.

Order of Business

at the Annual General Meeting shall be as follows:—

First—The Report shall be read, and its adoption proposed to the meeting.

Secondly—The Committee and Officers for the ensuing year shall be elected.

Thirdly—The Secretary-Treasurer, or any other authorized person, shall read all propositions, if any made for the alteration of the Rules, which shall be put to the meeting after being duly moved and seconded.

Fourthly—Any other Resolution, of which due notice shall have been given, shall be proposed in the same manner.

A Special General Meeting may be called by the Committee, on their own motion, or on a requisition signed by twenty-five (25) members, notice of such meeting and its object being exhibited in the Reading Room for a fortnight previous to its being holden. No other business will be discussed at such meeting but that for which it is summoned.

Reading Room.

The Room shall be open every day from 9 A. M. to 6.15 P. M., (Sundays excepted), for the accommodation of members, unless the Committee see it desirable to alter this arrangement, in which case they shall be at liberty to do so after having duly posted the necessary notice in the Reading Room.

Catalogues of the Books contained in the Library shall be placed for reference in the Reading Room, which shall be scientifically arranged.

The committee shall have power to fine, suspend, or expel any member who shall remove any book, newspaper, or other property of the Institute, contrary to rule, or without due permission.

No member shall be allowed to write or make any remark on any of the books or newspaper belonging to the Library, or otherwise deface or injure them, or damage other property of the Institute; and every member shall be responsible for whatever injury any volume may sustain while in his possession, or for its loss.

Silence and decorum must be preserved in the Reading Room

That all Newspapers and Periodicals shall be voted in by the Committee at a Special Meeting called for that purpose.

The Committee shall cause the Secretary to exhibit a list of papers, etc., 14 days previous to the day of meeting, such publication being considered as a nomination for their election.

Any two members wishing to have any Newspaper or Periodical added to or taken off the List of Papers in the room, must post a notice containing the title of such papers, etc., along with their own names, at least seven days previous to the said meeting.

The List of Papers, as voted in, shall remain in a conspicuous place in the Reading Room from one General Meeting to the other.

Trustees.

The Trustees of this Institute shall be the President of the Grand Trunk Railway, Board of Directors, and the Locomotive Superintendent.

Library.

The Library shall be open every lawful day for exchanging books.

No member shall have more than one volume at a time, unless the plates belonging to it are in a separate volume in which case both may be taken out at the same time, but must be returned at the expiration of the time allowed for one volume; exception to this Rule may be made by the special permission of the Committee.

A member on returning a book shall not take out the same again, until it has remained one clear day in the Library, nor then if it is wanted by any other member.

All books to be returned in 14 days from the date of issue; any member keeping it longer will be fined ONE CENT FOR EACH DAY beyond the time specified.

When H. R. H. the Prince of Wales visited the Works at Point St. Charles in 1861, he left with the Directors of the Grand Trunk Railway the sum of \$440 for the benefit of the employees. Mr. Blackwell consulted with the other Directors at a General Meeting and they, by mutual consent, handed the said amount over to the Committee of the "Literary and Scientific Institute," to be expended in the purchase of Books

BY-LAWS

FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE COMMITTEE AND OFFICERS,

PASSED AT A COMMITTEE MEETING, HELD OCTOBER, 1888.

A STARKE,
Secretary-Treasurer.

CHAIRMAN.

The Committee, at their first meeting after election, will appoint from their own number a chairman for the ensuing six months, who shall preside at all meetings of the committee, sign all minutes, authorise the Secretary to call meetings of committee. He shall, in the event of the Committee being equally divided, have the casting vote and no other, and is *ex-officio* a member of all sub-committees.

The sub-committees are Library, Finance, Room and Members' Admission.

LIBRARY.

They shall see that the books are kept in proper order, assist the Librarian in getting members to return books overdue, and to see that the fines are properly enforced. They shall as early as possible after their appointment, overhaul the books and report their condition to the General Committee. They shall report to that Committee all propositions that may have been received for new books, with their recommendation as to the advisability of adding them to the Library. The General Committee to give them their instructions as to purchasing the same.

FINANCE.

They shall receive from the other committees all bills that may have been received by them and, if found correct, submit them to the General Committee, who shall authorise the Secretary-Treasurer to pay them. They shall see that members do not get behind in their monthly payments, assisting the Librarian to collect the same. They shall, on the first meeting night of the month, furnish the General Committee with a list of all members three months in arrears.

ROOM.

They shall have a general supervision of the reading room, and see that the papers and periodicals are properly in their places and

in proper time, and on the occasions on which the dining room is used for lectures, &c., they shall see it properly fixed.

MEMBERS ADMISSION.

They shall see and examine all propositions, and, if found eligible, initial the forms. They shall meet not less than once a week for this purpose.

SECRETARY-TREASURER.

The Secretary will attend all meetings of the Institute and Committee Meetings. He will keep a book into which the minutes of all meetings will be entered, which minutes he will read at the next meeting thereafter, which, if approved of and signed by the Chairman, will be the official minutes. He will conduct all correspondence, issue notices, &c., as directed by the Committee.

He will receive all moneys due the Institute, and bank the same in his own name and the name of the two Trustees provided for that purpose. He will call on the Librarian at least once every week for all moneys he may have collected since his last visit.

LIBRARIAN.

The Librarian will open the Reading-room and Library every day, Sunday excepted, from 9 a.m. till 6.15 p.m. and in the winter months from 7.30 to 9.30.

He will have the care of all books, papers, pictures, &c., the property of the Institute. He will keep a register of members admitted to the Institute. He will keep a book into which he shall enter all books taken out of the Library by members. He will not admit any but members of the Library Committee to the book cases, and all books he cannot account for he will be responsible for them to the Committee. He will take cognizance of all books before issuing them, and on their being returned, should he find any of them mutilated or improperly used, he will report the same to the Committee, who will deal with the member offending. Books wanting rebinding, in his judgment, he will retain in Library, and submit to the Library Committee for their inspection. He will collect the subscriptions of members, handing the money so collected to the Treasurer at least once a week.

Members resigning must notify Librarian in writing, be clear on the books, and have all books returned.

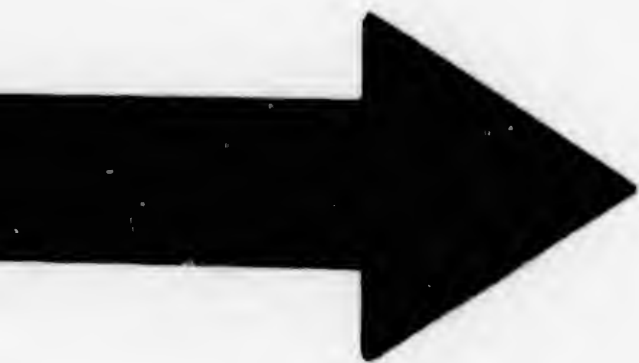
