Pasture Lands.

The care of pasture lands is a matter that receives too little attention from farmers in general, although upon this depends considerable measure the profits that we may expect to receive from growing stock.

Our pasture fields are usually selected from the lands for which we will least care, and the labor of cultivation; and so, because they are comparatively valueless, we think it will pay to give them the attention necessary to make them of greater value.

The stock is turned into these fields, to pick up what may be left. A pasture which is necessary to make them of greater value.

It is the first place, try and make it as good a pasture as possible. Clean off by mowing, or even plowing if necessary, weeds and trashy spots. Cut away all briars and brambles which may exist.
