CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

It is very encouraging to find that there are no indications of weakness in the lumber market as the weeks pass by. Most of the mills will continue sawing for another month or six weeks, and with the production perhaps a little heavier than usual, it would not be surprising if a downward tendency of prices were noticeable. However, the reverse is the case, and the mills are certain to close down with the market almost as strong as it has been at any period this year. The

stock of unsold lumber will be unusually light, as most grades of pine have been sold close up to the saws. It is predicted that there will be a shortage in pine stocks to supply the winter and early spring trade, and that the result will be a general advance in prices. It is estimated that in the Ottawa valley the stock of pine lumber is little more than half what it was at the corresponding time last year. The usual scarcity of cars for the movement of lumber has developed this fall. To analyze the market, it can be said that the greatest strength pertains to the high grades and stock boards, of which the supply is very light. Prices of these grades are particularly firm. The lower qualities are not active, although during the past week there has been a heavier movement of cheap building lumber and a better demand for box stuff. Manufacturers should as far as possible study the demands of the market and endeavor to curtail the production of the lower grades next season. Hardwood prices are irregular, and in the absence of the expected improvement in demand lower prices are being quoted by a few manufacturers who are anxious to realize. Increased buying by consuming industries is reported, but very little export trade is doing. Lath and shingles continue scarce. It is understood that on the Georgian Bay there is very little No. 2 lath on the market, and that prices of this grade are stiffening.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Notwithstanding the depression in the British market, the outlook for spruce is becoming brighter. No doubt a considerable quantity of spruce deals will be carried over on this side until next spring, but of specifications cut for other markets the quantity is unusually small. Liberal shipments have been made to France, Australia, South America, and the West Indies, and buyers of these stocks report that the mills are well cleaned out. It is probable that some of the large mills at St. John and Fredericton will be compelled to close down early in October on account of a scarcity of logs, about 38,000,000 feet being hung up on the St. John river and its tributaries. Cedar shingles are selling quite freely at \$3, on Boston rate of freight, and some manufacturers are asking even higher prices. Clears are quoted at \$2.70 and second clears at \$2.25. Laths are strong at \$3 for 1 1/2 inch and \$2.85 for 1 1/4 inch.

UNITED STATES.

White pine is this year the barometer

of the United States lumber market, and the degree of strength which that lumber is showing is little less than astonishing. The cutting season will be over in a few weeks, and from present indications the mills will close down with an unusually small stock of unsold lumber on hand to supply the demands of the winter and early spring. In some instances substitutes have been used for white pine, so that there has been a strengthening effect through the entire market. Within the past fortnight advances in price have been made at Ashland, Wis. Six-inch strips have been marked up to \$16, Norway to \$11, short and wide stuff to \$14, while 12-inch boards have been at a premium all summer. Saginaw dealers complain of difficulty in securing the assortments of white pine. A most hopeful report comes from Buffalo and Tonawanda. Dealers in these places are rushed with orders, the higher grades of pine being the strongest, with a good call for the middle grades. A further stiffening in the price of eastern spruce is reported from New York, and at Boston and Bangor the position of manufacturers is said to be growing stronger, 10 and 12 inch dimensions selling at \$19 to \$20, the highest, except in the fall of 1899, that has been quoted in twenty years. The cloud hanging over the hardwood market has not yet passed away. A slight improvement in the demand is noted in some districts, while as an offset to this it is stated that to effect sales low figures must be given to meet the competition of the weak holder. Birch and maple are showing more strength.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The past week has developed two factors in the British timber market—one unfavorable, the other favorable. Summing up the situation, the tone is a little more cheerful. The unfavorable aspect is that Norwegian and Swedish shippers are showing much anxiety to close contracts, and have offered to accept even lower prices than have been recorded this season. The low freight rates are an inducement to move the timber before the close of navigation. The hopeful outlook is found in the reduced quantity of deals and butens in the public docks on August 31st as compared with one month earlier. At the Surrey Commercial Docks, London, the stock of Baltic deals on August 31st was 1,701,654 pieces, as compared with 1,772,252 pieces on July 31st. Pine deals were represented by 680,000 pieces and spruce deals by 650,

600 pieces, as against 635,000 pieces and 421,000 pieces respectively on July 31st. The stock of battens represents almost the same proportion, which, in view of the import during the month, shows that the consumption has been quite heavy. Reference to the statistics for the port of Liverpool show that during the month of August the consumption of fifteen of the leading classes of timber exceeded the imports, or in other words, the importation of heavy timber amounted to 642,000 cubic feet, whilst the consumption was 1,185,000 cubic feet. In Quebec square and waney pine, and birch logs and planks, the demand exceeded the import. The quantity of spruce was reduced during the month by 5,150 standards. Pine deals have been imported moderately, but the consumption has been equally small. Reports speak very hopefully of the market for Canadian lumber. Referring to a recent sale the Timber Trades Journal says: "Canadian goods, if we except the common kinds of red pine that this year figure prominently in the stock, seem to make the best prices, though pine is much more plentiful in stock now than it was a year ago, but this applies to almost every class of wood." Of spruce the same journal says: "For some time past we have drawn special attention to the position of the spruce market; the limited quantity abroad for shipment and the increased demand for cargoes round the coast. The import into Liverpool during August was 13,800 standards, just one half of what it was last year, and with a good demand existing the consumption for the month is put down at 18,950 standards, which has pulled the stock down to 15,760 standards; in 1900 it stood at 28,594 standards and in 1899 at 22,252 standards. The position of spruce is thus made plain for the advance in prices to which we have from time to time referred."

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The head line steamer Teelin Head is loading a cargo of timber and deals at Quebec for Portsmouth, Eng.

R. A. Estey is loading scows at Fredericton, N. B., with spruce deals for shipment to Australia. They will be transferred to a steamer at St. John.

George Moffatt & Co. have just loaded

three vessels with lumber at Dalhousie, N. B., for Belfast, Ireland, the combined cargoes totalling about 2,300,000 feet.

Chicago quotations for lath are given as follows: No. 1 white pine, \$2.25; No. 1 mixed, \$2.75; No. 2 mixed, \$3.25. In the Saginaw valley quotations are: No. 1, \$3.50; No. 2, \$3; hemlock, \$3.

Three million feet of logs in charge of D. Cresswell and 4,000,000 feet in charge of D. Little came over the Fort Frances Falls last week for the Rat Portage Lumber Company. There is yet 14,000,000 feet to come to the mill.

M. M. Tingley, of Hopewell Hill, and Freeman Goodwin, of Moncton, N. B., have purchased the timber on the Johnson property near Bathurst. There is said to be 6,000,000 feet and it is proposed to take out 2,000,000 feet during the coming winter.

A two-mile berth on Little River, Sunbury county, N. B., was sold at the Crown Lands office, Fredericton, last week to Howard Holland, at \$8 per mile. Two berths in Queen's county, each two square miles, were sold to H. B. Hetherington, at the upset price of \$8 per mile.

At an auction sale held by Hodson, Mabbs & Co., London, Eng., on September 3rd, third Quebec spruce sold at £5 10s and £8 10s for regulars. Plasterer's laths brought 8½d, an advance of 2d over the prices which ruled at previous sales. On the following day a sale was held by Foy, Morgan & Company, when some poor quality spruce sold at £5 7s 6d for 3x9.

Under date of August 31st Messrs. S. P. Musson, Son & Co., say of the Barbadoes market: "There have been no arrivals to note during the fortnight. A small cargo of 70,000 feet white pine boards, 20,000 feet plank, and 6,000 feet spruce boards was put in the market, but has not been sold. A small cargo of about 100,000 feet, half each shipping and seconds, could doubtless be placed at about \$24 and \$18. Spruce is not inquired for yet and will not be much wanted before November. Long Gaspe and dimension shingles are wanted and should command fair rates. Laying cedar are saleable at about \$1.80 to \$2. There have been some sales of New York shooks for future delivery at \$1.45."

A correspondent at West Hartlepool, Eng., writes: "The demand for Quebec pine deals is very quiet just now. There is a fair stock of 1st and 3rd in the port, but 2nd are rather scarce. Round birch does not find a ready sale at the present time. A fair stock is held here, but enquiries are rare." A Gloucester correspondent says: "Spruce is decidedly better, and although there are still some few sellers who do not appear to have realized the fact that the supply to come forward from the other side is far below the average of normal seasons, their number is diminishing, and buyers generally are re-

nising in a substantial manner the very much improved values, particularly in the case of 3x9 in., whilst 3x11 in. and 7x2½ in., consequent upon the small percentages of those sizes now being shipped, are bound to shortly respond to even yet a greater advancement."

The most important sale of Ontario timber limits since the large sale of 1892 took place in the Parliament Buildings, Toronto, in the afternoon of Tuesday, 17th inst. There was an unusually large attendance of lumbermen from Canada and the United States, although most of the limits were purchased by Canadians. About fifteen townships were placed under the hammer by the well known timber limit auctioneer, Mr. Peter Ryan. The bidding was quite brisk, resulting in the sale at good prices of all the limits offered excepting three forfeited berths in the townships of Digby, Sherbourne and Lutterworth, which were withdrawn, the reserve bid not being reached.
