Island, which had a running account with the Bank of Montreal and acted as the latter's agent in the Island. The latter bank soon afterwards failed, and the Bank of Montreal reversed the former entry. The Government claims that the bank is the responsible party and should bear the loss, and has entered an action to recover the \$30,000.
