LABOR NOTES AND NEWS FROM ALL QUARTERS.

Interesting Items, Facts and Figures—A Bird's Eye View of the World of Industry.

CANADA

Mr. Jas. J. HURRY delivered an address before a Branch audience, Monday, Feb. 22nd, on the eight hour movement.

The Bathing Company is going to build a new wheel steamer to take the place of the steamer Quince, which was lost last year.

Twenty persons, nearly all belonging to the working classes, left Kingston on Cape Vincent on Monday for different points in the United States.

There is renewed trouble in Chown's Confectionery, Kingston, because of the refusal of the workers to work on the holidays.

It is stated that work will be resumed on the Calgary and Edmonton Railway as soon as the iron is out of the ground, and that the line will be completed to Edmonton early in July.

George E. TREVIER and Son have a tobacco factory situated on Queen street, Hamilton, was formally opened on Saturday afternoon.

The Cigarette Manufacturers Association of the United States has nearly 800,000 members.

New York millers make wages from sixteen to eighteen hours a day \$1.20 to \$1.50.

Spain has the world's largest lumber supply.

All the blacksmiths at Gloucester, Mass., who demanded nine hours, with one hour for lunch, the employers consenting to the change.

The first break in the strike of the first class men at Gloucester, N. J., which began September, 1890, occurred last week by several men going to work in the Whitney Brothers' factory.

Monday afternoon at Gloucester, Mass., went to work Monday on their schedule of nine hours and \$2.50 daily.

After negotiations which have been pending a year or more the big type foundry of the United States have effected a consolidation of their interests.

The capital involved is reported as \$1,000,000 and that the new concern will be the protection of the printer and to be the chief reason for consolidation of the thirty odd type foundries.

Mr. J. W. Nelson says "The number of idle laborers in Boston is estimated as follows: Longshoremen, 2,000; iron workers, 1,000; day laborers, 2,000; mechanics, 10,000; salesmen and clerks, 2,000; street car employees, etc., 7,500; hotel employees, 400; women, all branches, 8,000; miscellaneous, 7,000; total, 38,200."

A MANUFACTURER of dog harness, who has well to make the large scale of his product in district occupied by Italian laborers, has recently made the discovery that these men were being lured to buy meat, have been substituting largely upon dog meat as a substitute, laying it when fresh, and making it in their own establishments.

Only recently fifty per cent. of the immigration to this district is from the United States. German and twenty per cent. from various European nations.

The New York immigration has almost entirely ceased to come from the United States, but now about two-thirds of them remain in the New England and middle states.

The limited number of men of the Pennsylvania Company to their men were accepted by the men in the early days, and all threatened trouble has disappeared for the time at least. Still further compensation will be made by the company.

The extra time which has been the cause of so much complaint will be done away with. The men have no new compensation in almost anything they wished except an increase of wages. This was simply denied.
