An Act to amend chapter twenty-seven of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, "respecting Masters and Servants in the country parts."

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:— Preamble

1. The second section of the said chapter is hereby amended by inserting after "period," in the fifth line thereof, "who refuses or neglects to enter the service of his master at the time agreed upon, or who refuses or neglects to re-enter such service after having suffered imprisonment for contravention of this Act or." Sec. 2 of chap.

2. The fourth section of the said chapter is hereby amended by inserting after "agreement," in the second line, "or verbally before a witness or witnesses." Sec. 4 of chap.
27 of Con.
Stat. L. C.
amended.

3. The seventh section of the said chapter is hereby amended by inserting after "penalty," in the thirteenth line, "and costs," and after "chattels," in the fourteenth line, "and by the seizure of any sum of money that may be due to him by his master or mistress for salary or wages." 4. The eleventh section of the said chapter is hereby amended by leaving out "three" in the second line and inserting "six." Sec. 11 of chap.
27 of Con.
Stat. L. C.
amended.
