**An Act to amend the Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada, so far as relates to Incorporated Villages.**

Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows : Preamble.

1. The Council of every Incorporated Village shall have the same power as the Council of a City or Town to pass By-laws for the various objects set forth in the sub-sections numbered respectively from twelve to seventeen inclusive and those numbered nineteen and twenty of the two hundred and ninety-seventh section of chapter fifty-four of the consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled *An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada*, and the said sub-sections shall henceforward apply to Incorporated Villages as well as Towns and Cities in Upper Canada. Certain powers of City and Town Councils, extended to those of incorporated villages.
