### Montreal Stock Market.

**THE EARLY STRENGTH OF NEW YORK AND GOOD PACIFIC EARNINGS HELP THE BULLS—DULUTH STRONG—OUTSIDERS BUYING.**

There was a good amount of activity and life in to-day's market, an unusual amount of business for Saturday. The market was steady from the opening and in some case quite strong. Business was well distributed and all the favorites seemed to manifest a decided upward tendency.

It may be that Montreal has commenced to take the view of New York in regard to some shares which have been unusually active during the late rise, and attention will in the future be given more to those which have not participated to such an extent in the general rise. The trading this morning was well distributed and some of the lately neglected stocks were quite strong. We have so often been of the opinion that Canadian Pacific is on the eve of a boom and surely by its latest returns such a position would be well warranted.

It did not however act up to the expectations of the general public, although it was not heavily dealt in yet it did not maintain its opening advance, and closes to night at 86½ having sold at 86½. Twin City was merely steady and was well held considering the later weakness manifested in the New York market. Toronto Rails was firm after its weakness of yesterday and closes at the top figure of the day at 114½ the fluctuations were not extensive only 795 shares changing hands.

Montreal Street was steady at 293 but only for a small sale of 3 shares Royal Electric was inclined to do better and after its late inaction it can afford to be generous it closes to night at 163½.

Dominion Cotton was quite and for 85 shares sold at 111 this stock seems to be very well held and is in a strong position. We should not be surprised to see this sell at a still higher figure before long.

Montreal Gas was firm at 213 and 212½ and Richelieu and Ontario at 107. War Eagle was a little off from the best and closes to night at 343 a couple of points off from the list of the day.

In other stocks the Duluths were steady at about the same prices as formerly.
