### The Causes of the Depression.

Owing to the first explanation that is generally given of every financial crisis. Warehouses are full and shops well supplied with goods, as a rule, when money squeezes come, and many of the holders are unable to sell rapidly enough to meet the notes they have given for the goods. What would have been only a fair stock, therefore, in ordinary times, becomes a superfluity when trade is depressed. The decrease in demand for our staples at profitable rates is another cause of the present stagnation, and the smallness of the profits in the carrying business generally account for the lack of funds on the part of a great many. A pause in building operations in the United States, and general depression in that country have reduced the price of lumber and caused a fall in Atlantic freights. This, of course, no wisdom on the part of the Canadian Government or mercantile and manufacturing interests could have foreseen. It is to be blamed for having aggravated these evils by its meddlesome and blundering course. We have called attention more than once to the feeling of uncertainty and uneasiness with which the stockholders and middlemen of the Government inspired every branch of trade and manufacturing industry, and are satisfied that the tariff tinkering and the want of confidence in Governmental policy, in the hands of the present administration, has had a more direct influence on the business of the country than any other cause.

### Constitutional Troubles.

The French Assembly always gets into a snarl when constitutional bills come up for discussion. Bills for giving any regulation of the force of fundamental laws to the executive, or for giving the executive power to suspend laws, are not introduced in the Assembly, on Tuesday of this week, M. Dufaure submitted a bill regulating the relations between the public powers. It provides that the Senate shall be dissolved in January and at least five months in the year. The President of the Republic may communicate with the Chamber by message. The Chambers are obliged to reconsider any decision if the President makes a request to that effect. The President and Ministers can be impeached only by the Chamber of Deputies, and must be tried by the Senate. M. Dufaure also introduced a bill relative to the organization of the Senate. It provides that decisions for Senators shall be ordered by the President of the Republic, which must be issued six months before the day fixed for the holding of the election. A motion was made by the Minister of the Interior that the bill be referred to the Committee of Thirty. The Left opposed the motion and urged that the bills be referred to a special committee. M. Dufaure's motion was defeated, when M. Baudry was appointed that the Committee of Thirty, a member of the Committee of Thirty, refused to do so. M. 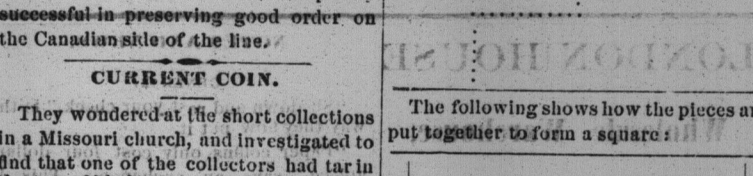

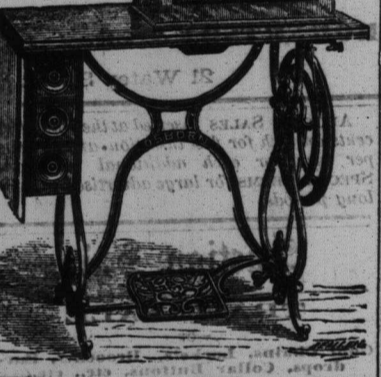
