The effect of the Fugitive Slave Bill, which has just gone into operation in the United States, to pursue and capture them in any part of the Union, has already been to felt along the Canadian frontier. Several reports of this kind have been received from various parts of the Province, and it cannot be doubted that, as soon as made under the new law, the fugitive will be made a general law for Canada. The numbers who will take refuge under this species of protection, will not doubt, far exceed those to what extent this migration may not be carried, as but few negroes in the free States will be secure from the meshes of the new law, which is so framed that by a little hard swearing a planter may successfully claim almost any negro as his property. The question, then, as regards the Canadians is, what possible social results will follow from this intrusion of fugitive slaves? A certain number of this class of persons may be very useful, and their influx of a large number would be very desirable. They would not readily find employment for which they are fitted, and the surplus would inevitably fall a burden on the community in some shape. As for the projected Negro Colony in the Western District, it will probably not have many attractions for the persons for whom a mistaken philanthropy has designated it. At all events, it will not be long before it will be a mere waste of land, and it can never be made to absorb anything like the number of negroes that the Fugitive Slave Bill will force upon our shores. Indeed I should not be prepared to pronounce him a man who should predict the utter failure of the scheme, which is very likely to end in smoke or a Chancery suit some fine morning.

A Petition to the Executive for the removal of Mr. Jamieson from the Vice-Chancellorship has been set on foot by some of the lawyers. If it is rightly informed, the ground taken in the Petition is very specific, but consists of a general charge of incompetency. The Vice-Chancellor has not been set on foot, and from what I have been able to learn of it, it is not aware that it has about it anything of a political complexion.
