Montreal Stock Market.

HEAVY INCREASE IN C. P. R. EARNINGS CAUSES STRENGTH—ELECTRIC ROAD INCREASES—CONTINUE—GAS NEGLECTED—WAR EAGLE BOOMS.

There was slight irregularity at this morning's session of the Stock Exchange, but no changes of importance occurred. The demand from investors was small and in no way affected prices. Wall Street keeps up its advance, and some issues there are specially strong. London prices were in touch with New York prices, the buying and selling from that quarter being about even. Operators allow their lines of stocks to accumulate here and have no fear of reactions. The leading shares are so well held that for the present they are more than likely to have a further rise.

Pacific opened strong and remained so; a large business was done in it. For the first time in weeks it assumed its old place of "leader." The large increased earnings for the last ten days of December were sufficient to cause a rise. A speculative interest is gradually growing in it, and as soon as activity is resumed it will sell at a much better range.

Toronto Railway acted stronger this morning than it has yet done, remaining steady around 110. The defeat of MacDonald as Mayor of Toronto should in itself have caused a rise of five points. This stock is making steady, which is better than occasional phenomenal earnings. The receipts for last month as shown in another column are highly satisfactory.

War Eagle was strong at 305 to 305½. Business in it was not large but all stock offered was taken. It closed at 305 to 306. Gas sold at 209½ and 209½ being offered at last price with 209 bid. It should be bought on weak days. The general business of the board was good and covered many stocks. Prices were generally unchanged.
