SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS  
TO VISIT THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA  
AUGUST 17-27, 1981

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mark MacGuigan, will pay an official visit to the People's Republic of China from August 17-27 at the invitation of Vice Premier and Minister of Foreign Affairs Huang Hua.

The Minister will be accompanied by a delegation of parliamentarians, senior officials and representatives of the private sector. (See delegation list on reverse side.)

While he is in China, he will visit Peking, Shaanxi Province and Sichuan Province.

In Peking, Dr. MacGuigan will hold discussions with Vice Premier Huang Hua on international and bilateral questions, and will meet with other senior Chinese leaders. He will also make an address on "Canada, China, and the Rule of Law".
