MacDiarmid stated that a concrete road, built under favorable conditions, fif- teen feet in width, cost $\$ 18,000$ a teen feet in width, edst $\$ 18,000$ a mile in Essex last year. The next mile would probably cost more, because of a longer baul. Mr. MacDiarmid said that a macadam road would probably cost about $\$ 9,000$ a mile, and a gravel road between $\$ 3,000$ and $\$ 5,000$ a mile. Referring to the route of the highway, the Minister said that the Prime Minister had promised to secure all the facts before making an announcewould follow.
