### Montreal Stock Market.

**MORE BUSINESS AND HIGHER PRICES, THOUGH MARKET STILL DULL.**

Montreal, July 12.

With Royal Electric and Gas leading, this was quite a brisk day of good business in the Stock Exchange. London and other quotations were favorable for business and from Chicago, Liverpool, and other centers came news of revival among the dry bones. Most of the money given out had got back to the banks again, and money was easy. The local market shared in the general revival. Holders were willing to sell and buyers gave prices which compared favorably with previous values. There must be reasons for the sales which took place, but that any uneasiness about the stock was the reason must be repudiated in the face of its enlarged valuations.

**Canadian Pacific**—Of this security 350 shares were sold, most of them at  $\frac{1}{2}$  above yesterday's highest. Business stopped with sellers at 98 and buyers offering 97 $\frac{1}{2}$ .

**Commercial Cable**—At 185 $\frac{1}{2}$ , which was  $\frac{1}{4}$  lower than Monday's price, 25 shares were sold; 185 $\frac{1}{2}$  was wanted with 185 bid.

**Royal Electric**—There were 10 sales of this stock, the smallest lot 10 shares and the largest 100. The highest price was 181 the lowest 179 $\frac{1}{2}$ , that is from 1 to 2 points less than yesterday. There has been considerable stir in this stock these last two days and there has been a good standard of price kept up. Wanted 180, offered 179 $\frac{1}{2}$ .

**New Montreal Street**—For the first time

this week this security appears on the list of active stocks, when 25 shares were sold at 325 the same as the lowest on July 6th. Closing offers were 320 with 325 $\frac{1}{2}$  wanted.

**War Eagle**—At about 2 less than yesterday's quotations 1500 shares of this security were traded in, 1000 at 367 and 500 at 366. There was wanted at close 368, and offered 365.

**Payne**—In this mining stock also values shrank 2 from Tuesday's mark and 500 shares sold at 138. A chasm of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  separated sellers from buyers, the former wanting 139 $\frac{1}{2}$  the latter offering 134.

**Montreal Cotton**—2 shares of this stock were disposed of at 155, 1 less than on July 5th. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  was offered at closing with 160 wanted.

**Gas**—Every one of the six sales of this stock to-day were at a price not less than the only deal of last week, 200. To-day, prices were 200 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 200 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 201, and 201 $\frac{1}{2}$ . Total of shares sold, 191. The closing brought out an offer of 200 against which there was a demand for 200 $\frac{1}{2}$ .

**Halifax Heat & Light**—25 shares at 25, which is 1 less than previous price. It closed with 21 $\frac{1}{2}$  offered and 26 $\frac{1}{2}$  bid.

**Banks**—Molsons at  $\frac{1}{4}$  better than last sale, Commerce at the same price as last, Quebec at an advance of 5 on last sale; Bank of Montreal at  $\frac{1}{4}$  over last sale. These bank stock shares were in larger lots than has been usual of late.

# NEW YORK EXCHANGE.

**STRONG MARKET—A. B. ROCKETS UP TO 204.**

New York, July 12.

The tendency of the American market in London seems to be towards improvement, but there is comparatively little doing. Rothschild brokers are reported to be buyers of L.N. Uneasiness still exists over the Transvaal as shown by a further decrease of 5-16, making a total in last 3 days of over 1 point. The N.Y. Sun in its morning article, states that the unsatisfactory nature of Saturday's Bank Statement was due to several extraordinary occurrences; the influence of which has now disappeared, and the article predicts a very favorable statement on Saturday. It appears that last week \$8,000,000 were taken in connection with the flotation of a new industrial and \$6,000,000 as a result of the floating of the securities of the Mass. Traction Co. New York city was also a heavy borrower. In addition, there were the usual heavy payments incident to the 1st of July. A considerable proportion of these sums paid out, have come back to the banks this week.

Remittances have also been received from the interior as a result of the high rates for call money. In view of these facts it may be safely said that for the time being the dangers of tight money have been removed.

Although yesterday's market was less active than Monday's, as a rule Monday's losses were all recovered. The Street is inclined to look for an upward movement. The extraordinary St. Paul earnings led to considerable buying of the stock both here and abroad.

The weekly Government crop report was of a favorable nature, the bears generally are rather discouraged, in fact the outlook seems to be for generally higher prices.

New York, Noon, July 12.

The almost total disappearance of any apprehension in regard to the money market, resulted in a larger Commission House business than for some days, and also in a continuation of the covering movement which was largely responsible for yesterday's advance. London operations were mixed arbitrageous selling considerable Atchison preferred and C.O.N. a moderate line of St. Paul, and buying about 6,000 D. & N.

There is a curious absence of local interest in this stock, but the foreign buying is of a very good character. The features of

the market were M. O. P., S. S. pfd., Man. and T. C. I.

There was a revival of the rumors of the Consolidation of all the Gould systems in the South and the buying of M. O. P. and S. S. pfd. was decidedly good.

There is a suspicion that the heavy selling of Manhattan a few days ago was for short account and apparently the insiders are endeavoring to force this short interest to cover, so as to create a market upon which they can sell.

Outside of this manipulation, however, it is believed that the best informed people are very sanguine as to the prospects of the company, and predict that as soon as the electrical equipment of the system has been accomplished, there will be a very large increase in the earnings.

T. C. I. after a strong opening declined owing to the sales of some 8,000 shares by a broker supposed to represent some inside interest. The sale of this block only caused a decline of 1 p.c., and at present, there is not very much stock for sale. Generally speaking the Room is bullish, believing that railway earnings will be large for some time, and that as soon as the crops are out of danger the public will once more enter the market and bring about a considerably higher range of prices.

A prospector who came over from Clayoquot to test the truth of the report, took one pan of sand from the beach, carried it down to the water, and as a result of his labors got \$2.50 from the one pan.

The fact of the discovery is vouched for by a number of people arriving by the Willapa who saw the gold being washed out.

# CHICAGO MARKET.

**MARKET LOCAL — PROVISIONS**  
STILL RISING, WITH GRAIN ON THE TURN.

Chicago, July 12.

What difference there existed in the market this morning arose from an apparent cessation of downward prices in grain. There were  $\frac{1}{2}$  advances at the opening on all classes of wheat and corn, also in July oats. September and December oats opened with the figures at which they closed yesterday. This was but a slight movement towards a higher grain market. It was, however, a commencement, and it was continuously followed up as the day advanced. In its earlier stages the market was strong, not, indeed, in a spasmodic way, but naturally, beginning and progressing quietly but surely. Whether a bullish grain business has set in, remains to be seen, but symptoms were pointing in that direction. Sales of provisions however, showed at the opening no abatement in their upward movement. September pork, starting with an advance of 10 cents on yesterday's close, bettered this in the morning by another 2, 3, and 2 cents, reaching 9.07. September ribs, from a close at 5.12, rose early in the day to 5.25. Most of the business was in these two classes of provisions.

New York provision market is quoted as proceeding on the same lines.

Barrett was a large buyer of wheat at these slightly improved prices, which it is thought will work higher, owing to there being very little wheat offered.

Hogs received to-day, 23,000, and 30,000 estimated for to-morrow.

Primary receipts last week, 1,619,005; shipments, 1,141,710; last year shipments being 156,515, with shipments, 93,456.

Car lots received: Wheat 90, shipments 9,000; corn 415, shipments 218,205; oats, 163, shipments 9,805.
