**BEVER'S HAS BEEN KEPT FROM POSSESSION.**

**Head of the Army Now Occupies the Boers' Arms for Possession.**  
British Lost Seven Officers and One Hundred Men—Roberts is Now Using Methuen's Transport—Canadian Mounted Rifles at Kenhardt.

London, March 30.—(4-15 a.m.)—The head of the arms of Lord Roberts is now about 21 miles north of Bloemfontein. It occupies a cluster of hills, won from the Boers after a stiff fight, in which the British lost seven officers and one hundred men.

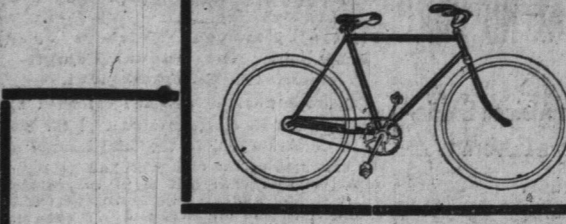

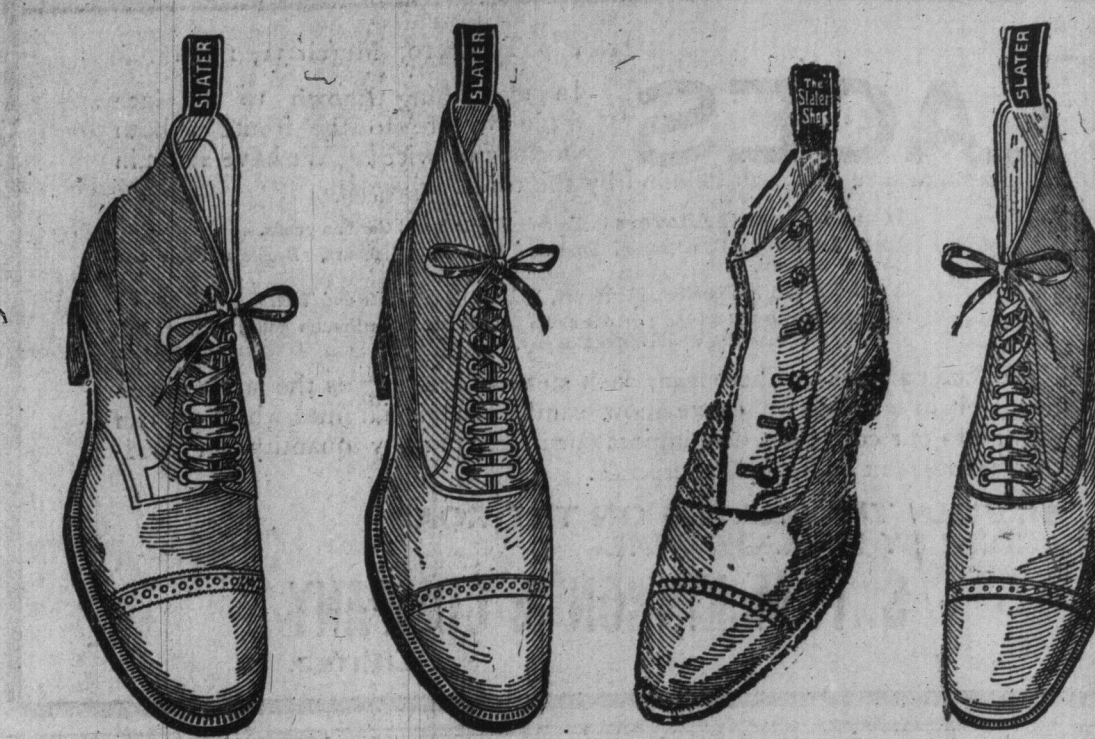
