HOW IT WORKS IN TWO OF ST. JOHN'S LARGEST SCHOOLS. Chairman Thorne and Superintendent Hayes furnish most interesting and convincing proof of the efficiency of the Fire Drill in the Victoria and Central Buildings—700 pupils demonstrated in one and a half minutes.
