NEWS FROM FAR AND NEAR.

A second Congress of Chambers of Commerce of the British Empire will be held in London in June. The Pope hopes to be buried in the Lateran by the side of Innocent III., whose tomb he has just finished there. A farmer living near Lawrence, Kan., does a profitable business raising sparrows and selling them to the restaurants as rood birds. A dissolute linguist, a teacher of seven different languages, has been jailed at Laramie, Wyo., for beating his wife, who supported him by taking in washing. There has just died in Poland a once celebrated beauty, who refused the hand of Napoleon III. She was the Princess Helene Sagonko, and died unmarried at the age of 57. The grand total of charitable bequests in England during the past year, excluding Baron Huggins's \$10,000,000 for Jewish emigration, was \$15,000,000, as against \$11,500,000 in 1890. A young Norwegian in Minnesota felt heir to a baronetcy and fortune in Norway, and the good news so excited him that he proceeded to get drunk and was frozen to death in a barn. The good people of Gloucester took much pleasure a week ago in seeing the bishop, aged 73, appear with his skates and indulge in an afternoon's display of his proficiency, which is very great. The Grand Duchess Stephanie is admitted to be one of the finest horsewomen in Europe, but she is now confined to her room as the result of being thrown from a French horse, which had no respect for an Imperial hat in the saddle. Lord Rosebery says that the Earl of Beaconsfield told him that an old member of Parliament who was in the death chamber at the time of the late Duke of Devonshire, said to Mr. Pitt's last words, "I could eat one of Bismarck's meat pies"—referring to a delicacy highly prized at that time in London. A California girl, Miss Alice Rideout, has been awarded the task of executing the sculpture to adorn the Woman's Building at the World's Fair. She has designed three figures for this purpose, representing "Woman's Virtues," "Woman as the Spirit of Civilization," and "Woman's Place in History."
