

Prince Edward Island's Prohibition.

Prohibition

Prohibition does not prohibit, is the constant cry of those who are pinched by prohibition, and those who, without looking up the facts, or even doing a little common-sense thinking, accept anti-prohibition statements without a question as to their origin. Prince Edward Island is the only Province of Canada which has a Provincial Prohibitory Law. Its experience is valuable testimony as to the effects of such a law. A recent number of the Charlottebow, Guardian deals editorially with the matter thus: The law has proved to be most beneficial in this city In the old days, with 2,000 less people, we kept sixteen policemen. Now we have but six—one on duty at the police station at night, another there by day, and only two patrolmen on duty by day and two by night about the city. All the evils predicted to result from Prohibition have failed to materialize. It was said prohibition would only lead to more drunkenness; that it would injure trade and so on.
