Dispose all our hearts to receive them With sincere Gratitude; and enjoy them in cheerful Obedience to Thee, the Author of all Good. Grant, We beseech thee, proportionable Success to our Allies, and give them Rest from Perils and Calamities. May our Neighbouring Enemies perceive, that Thou fightest against them, and submit to equitable Terms of Peace. May the remotest Nations, With Whom we have Concerns, acknowledge that our God ruleth over all. And may we behave towards them With such Justice, Humanity and Prudence, and live in their Sight so righteously, soberly, and godly, that they may honour, instead of blaspheming, the Worthy Name whereby we are called, and the Heathen become the Inheritance, and the utmost parts of the Earth the possession of thy beloved Son: To whom, With Thee, O Father, and the Holy Ghost, be all Glory and Praise, now and for ever. Amen.
