St Catharines, Ont., the *Canadian
Philatelic Journal* aged 7 months.

and badly mixed pitch and mud (for ink).

The cause of its sudden collapse is
doubtful, but it is supposed that Mr.

sold it to C. B. Reece of St. Catharines,
in order to free himself of having the
thing dieing on his hands. Mr. R.
has failed to connect and the subscrip-
tion list and advertising contracts will
be filled by us.

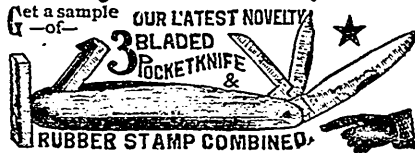
