Rules and Regulations.

1. This Association will be known as Name. the "Quebec Garrison Club."

2. The Staff of the Seventh Military District and the Officers of the several Active Volunteer Militia Corps, having their head quarters at the City of Quebec, Membership. are alone eligible as members. They shall be members *ex-officio* and without ballot, even if they remove their residence from Quebec, provided they comply with Rule No. 32.

3. All the concerns of the Club shall be managed by a Committee, to consist committee. of the staff of the Seventh Military District, the Commandant of the Cavalry School Corps, the Commandant of the Royal School of Artillery, the senior officer of the Queen's Own Canadian Hussars, the Quebec Field Battery, the Sth Royal Rifles and the 9th Battalion "Voltigeurs de Québec," and one retired officer of the Active Force, and also of one

officer, to be chosen by each corps respectively, from "A" Troop of the Cavalry School Corps, the Queen's Own Canadian Hussars, the "A" or "B" Battery, Regiment of Canadian Artillery, the Quebec Field Battery, the Sth Royal Rifles and the 9th Battalion "Voltigeurs de Québee," (all being members of the Club.) The five members so chosen shall hold office for one year, but shall be eligible for re-election. An Honorary-Treasurer. an Honorary-Secretary. a Secretary-Treasurer and the said retired officer of the Active Force (being a member of the Club.) shall be elected at each annual general meeting and shall be ex-officio members of the Committee. Vacancies occurring in the Committee shall be filled up at once when they occur.

Duties of the Committee, 4. The Committee shall have full control of the management of the Club, and it shall be the duty of the Committee to enforce the rules of the Club. 5. The Committee, three of whom shall quorum. form a quorum, shall meet once a fortnight, or oftener, to transact current business.

6. The annual subscription shall be Annual Subscription. twelve dollars, and no members shall be admitted to vote on any occasion what-Right to vote. ever, or enjoy any of the privileges of the Club, until he shall have paid his subscription. Members joining after 31st Half yearly March, will pay only half the annual ^{subscription}.

7. All annual subscriptions shall be to whom paid. paid to the Secretary-Treasurer.

8. Gentlemen who are not members of privileged memthe District Staff or of the Active Militia Force of the City of Quebec, are eligible as privileged members, and shall pay an Entrance fee. entrance fee of \$25 and a subscription of \$12 per annum.

10. Candidates must be proposed by one ordinary member and seconded by another, and their names inserted in the Candidates' Book kept for that purpose. The names of all Candidates must be posted in the Reading Room for at least seven days before they are submitted for election.

Privileges of Candidates.

Delay to pay subscription. 11. On the admission of each new member, the Secretary-Treasurer shall notify him of the same. No candidate shall have the right to enjoy any of the privileges of the Club, until he shall have paid his subscription, and if the subscription of such new member be not paid within one month after his admission, his name shall be erased from the list of members of the Club, unless be can jusС

12. The subscription shall be paid on Subscription due. the 1st October in each year.

13. The name of every member failing to pay his annual subscription, after having received notice, or during the course of the month of October, shall be arrears. exhibited in the Reading Room on the first of November then next; and if the subscription be not paid on or before the 15th day of November, the Secretary-Treasurer shall erase his name from the Posting and rasing of list of members. Should, however, the names. ex-member assign reasons for the nonpayment, which, in the opinion of the Committee, shall appear satisfactory, the Re-admittence. Committee shall be empowered to readmit him upon payment of arrears.

15. Any ordinary or privileged member whose dues are all paid, shali be at liberty to withdraw from the Club on his written application to that effect.

Ordinary members. 16. An ordinary member retiring from the Active Militia Force, retaining rank, may remain an ordinary member of the Club and be eligible as an officer of the said Club.

Expulsion of members. 17. If the conduct of any member, ordinary or privileged, either in or out of the Club House, shall, in the opinion of the Committee, or of any five members, ordinary or privileged, of the Club (who shall certify the same in writing), be injurious to the character and interests of the Club, the Committee shall be empowered to recommend such member to resign. If such member shall not resign within a month from the delivery of such letter of recommendation, the Committee shall be authorized and required to erase his name from the list of members, and the person whose name is so erased shall cease to be a member of the Club, provided that no such recommendation be sent to any member unless the resolution to send the same shall have been agreed to by two-thirds of the members of the Committee, actually present at a meeting specially summoned for that purpose, of which nine must be the quorum; provided also, that if, upon such meeting of the Committee so specially summoned, two-thirds of the Committee assembled shall be of opinion that the character and interests of the Club require the immediate expulsion of the member whose conduct is in question, the Committee shall be empowered forthwith to expel such member, and in such case such member shall be forever afterwards ineligible to enter the Club House.

18. Any ordinary or privileged meni-strangers ber, with the sanction of a member of the Committee, shall have the privilege of introducing a friend, not a resident of the District of Quebec, for a period not ex15 days only.

ceeding 15 days, to enjoy the use of the Club. But the member so introducing him shall be responsible for his conduct in the Club and for any dues incurred by him. Such visitor cannot introduce any other stranger. Stranger, so introduced: cannot be put up by members more than once in every three months.

Transient privileged members.

Officers of the Imperial Army, Navy and Canadian Staff and other strangers not residing within the District of Quebec and whose residence here is temporary, may. upon the introduction of a member and with the sanction of the Committee, be admitted as "Transient Privileged Members," upon payment of \$2 per month.

Six months.

This privilege shall not extend over six months.

Use of the Club.

19. No resident of the City or Banlieu, who is not a member of the Club, can be brought in or allowed to make use of the Club, unless invited by a member to breakfast, lunch or dinner.

20. Politics and religious questions of Politics, &c. every description shall be absolutely excluded from the objects of the Club.

21. The Club House shall be opened at Hours. 8.30 A.M., and closed at 12.30, except on Saturday and Sunday nights, when the Club will be closed at midnight. No member shall be admitted into the Club outside of these hours on any pretence whatever, unless specially authorized by the Committee.

22. No books or newspapers are to be Books, &c. removed from the Club, and no paper or notice, written or printed, shall be put Notices. up in the Club without the sanction of 'the Committee.

23. No servants of the Club shall be servants. sent out of the house upon any errands, or on any pretence whatever.

Complaints.

24. Any cause of complaint, which may arise, shall be signified in writing to the Committee, whose duty it shall be to investigate it at their next meeting.

Payment of dues.

25. Members are required to pay their bills for every expense incurred, before they leave the house. The servants are held accountable for the observance of this rule.

Suspension and expulsion.

26. Any member infringing the above rule shall be liable to be suspended or expelled from the Club, at the discretion of the Committee.

Dogs.

Games.

27. No member shall bring a dog into the Club.

28. No game shall, on any account, be played for money, except Whist, Ecarté, Piquet. or Pool; nor Dice used in the Club House, except at Backgammon. No higher stake than quarter-dollar points shall be played for at Whist; nor shall any bet exceed one dollar; the

29. Any article of this constitution may constitution. be altered, amended or suspended for any length of time, by consent of two-thirds of the members present at any meeting specially convened for that purpose, and provided such alteration, amendment or suspension shall have been specified in the notice summoning such meeting, and that at such meeting twenty members at least be present.

30. The Annual General Meeting of the Annual general meeting. Club shall be held on the second Wednesday in October in each year, at 7.30 o'clock P. M., for the purpose of receiving the report of the Committee, and of making any alterations or additions to the Constitution which may be considered advisable. Two Auditors shall be Auditors. elected at each annual meeting, who shall examine the accounts and report thereon, and also examine them from time to time, and report thereon at the next annual meeting. Another meeting shall be held on the Wednesday fortnight, for the purpose of deciding on such propositions as may have been submitted at the former meeting.

Adjourned meeting.

31. The Committee may call a Special Special meeting. General Meeting when they think fit, on giving fourteen days notice, to be posted up during that period in the Reading Room. The Committee may also call a Special General Meeting upon the requisition of twelve members in writing. The requisition must specify, in the form of a resolution, the matter intended to be submitted to the meeting, at which the discussion shall be limited to such matter only. No Special General Meeting shall be valid unless twelve members, exclusive of any member of the Committee, be present.

32. Any ordinary or privileged mem-

ber who shall remove his residence from Members re-Quebec (all his subscriptions then due residence. being paid), may give notice to the Secretary-Treasurer of such removal and of his intention not to make use of the Club thenceforward, and such member shall pay a yearly subscription of four dollars (\$4.00), if an ordinary member, and two dollars (\$2.00), if a privileged member, so long as he continues to reside out of Quebec, and he shall retain the privileges and benefits of such membership in all matters. Such member shall, at any time, have the right of again using the Club by notifying his intention so to do and paying his subscription for the current year.

But if, any member so removing his Return of members. residence from Quebec and taking advantage of this rule should again return to Quebec, he shall, within one month from such return, notify the Secretary-Treasurer and pay the subscription for the current year and, failing so to do, his

name shall be struck from the roll of members, unless some good excuse be offered the Committee to account for his neglect.

Rights of membets.

33. Any member who shall withdraw, resign or be expelled shall cease to be a member of the Club and shall, *ipso facto*, forfeit all right or claim thereto or to its property or funds.

Winding up.

24. In case it should be necessary, at any time, to wind up the affairs of the Club, the balance, at the credit of the Club, shall be divided among the then ordinary members *pro rata* to the subscriptions they have paid as such ordinary members. Hi
