An Act to amend the Act respecting the division of Lower Canada into Counties, as regards representation in the Legislative Assembly.

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter the limits of the Counties of St. John, Napierville and Laprarie, respectively, for the purpose of representation in the Legislative Assembly, and to amend chapter seventy-five of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada in that behalf: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. For the purpose of representation in the Legislative Assembly, but for no other, the Parish of St. Jacques Le Mineur, now comprised for such purpose in the County of Laprarie, shall hereafter be comprised in the County of St. John; the Parish of Lacolle, now comprised for such purpose in the County of St. John, shall be comprised in the County of Napierville; and the Parish of St. Rémi, including the Village of St. Rémi, now comprised for such purpose in the County of Napierville, shall be comprised in the County of Laprarie; and chapter seventy-five of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada is hereby amended accordingly.

Boundaries of the Counties of St. John, Napierville, and Laprarie altered for representation only.
